## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2143

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 17 and insert:
- **"SECTION 1.** ORS 169.070 is amended to read:
- 3 "169.070. (1) The Department of Corrections shall provide and coordinate
- state services to local governments with respect to local correctional facili-
- 5 ties and juvenile detention facilities. The Director of the Department of
- 6 Corrections shall designate staff to provide technical assistance to local
- 7 governmental agencies in the planning and operation of local correctional
- 8 facilities, lockups, temporary holds and juvenile detention facilities, and ad-
- 9 vice on provisions of state law applicable to these facilities. The department
- shall inspect local correctional facilities, lockups, temporary holds and ju-
- venile detention facilities, to ensure compliance with the standards estab-
- lished in ORS 169.076 to 169.078, 169.740, 419A.059 and 419B.180.
  - "(2) In carrying out its duties under subsection (1) of this section, the
- 14 department may enter into agreements with public or private entities to
- conduct inspections of local correctional facilities, lockups, temporary holds
- 16 and juvenile detention facilities.

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- "(3) When a county that operates a local correctional facility has
- 18 conducted, or caused a public or private entity to conduct, an in-
- 19 spection of the local correctional facility within 24 months before an
- 20 inspection would be conducted under subsection (1) of this section, the
- 21 department is not required to conduct the next inspection required
- 22 under subsection (1) of this section if:

- "(a) The standards meet or exceed the standards established in ORS 1 169.076; 2
  - "(b) The inspection is conducted in a manner that allows the county to satisfy the requirement of paragraph (c) of this subsection; and
  - "(c) Within 45 days after the inspection is completed, the county provides to the department:
- "(A) A statement or copy of the standards used to conduct the in-7 spection and the date the standards were adopted; and
  - "(B) A portion of the findings and recommendations of the inspection that is the equivalent of the information that would have been obtained in an inspection conducted under subsection (1) of this section.
  - "(4) The information provided to the department under subsection (3) of this section is a public record for the purposes of ORS 192.410 to 192.505 and is subject to the same disclosure requirements and retention schedule that applies to an inspection conducted under subsection (1) of this section.".

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
