

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2742**

1 Delete lines 6 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in sections 2 and 3 of this 2013 Act, ‘non-**  
3 **credit academic activity’ means an academic activity offered by a**  
4 **public university listed in ORS 352.002 for which academic credit is not**  
5 **offered for participation. ‘Noncredit academic activity’ includes, but**  
6 **is not limited to:**

7 **“(a) Auditing an academic course; or**

8 **“(b) Participating in a continuing education or community educa-**  
9 **tion program.**

10 **“(2) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 may not refuse a stu-**  
11 **dent application to, or enrollment or participation in, any noncredit**  
12 **academic activity solely on the basis that the student:**

13 **“(a) Is a high school graduate who was not awarded a standard high**  
14 **school diploma or General Educational Development (GED) certificate;**  
15 **or**

16 **“(b) Has a modified or extended diploma as described in ORS 329.451.**

17 **“(3) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 may not adopt any**  
18 **school policy with respect to a noncredit academic activity that treats**  
19 **a student differently from other students of the university solely on**  
20 **the basis that the student:**

21 **“(a) Is a high school graduate who was not awarded a standard high**  
22 **school diploma or General Educational Development (GED) certificate;**

1 or

2 “(b) Has a modified or extended diploma as described in ORS 329.451.

3 **“SECTION 3. Nothing in section 2 of this 2013 Act may be construed**  
4 **to limit or otherwise prevent a public university listed in ORS 352.002**  
5 **from:**

6 “(1) Setting academic or other requirements to measure  
7 preparedness or qualification to participate in a noncredit academic  
8 activity;

9 “(2) Limiting the number of individuals who are not seeking aca-  
10 demic credit from participating in an academic activity;

11 “(3) Granting credit-seeking students priority enrollment in an ac-  
12 ademic activity before allowing noncredit-seeking students to enroll  
13 in the academic activity on a first-come, first-served basis; or

14 “(4) Limiting the types or number of courses in which individuals  
15 who are not seeking academic credit may participate.”.

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
