

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2927**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Governor shall submit a written report to the**  
3 **2014 regular session of the Legislative Assembly on best practices for**  
4 **the use of boards, commissions, task forces and work groups as tools**  
5 **for better government and as resources for engaging and conducting**  
6 **public outreach with Oregonians.**

7 **“(2) The report may include:**

8 **“(a) Criteria or conditions that must be met prior to the establish-**  
9 **ment of a board, commission, task force or work group;**

10 **“(b) Criteria or rules of procedure that must be included in the**  
11 **statute or other organizational document establishing or modifying**  
12 **the duties of the board, commission, task force or work group;**

13 **“(c) Information on costs routinely incurred in administering a**  
14 **board or commission;**

15 **“(d) Recommended training for members of a board, commission,**  
16 **task force or work group;**

17 **“(e) Recommended processes for receiving, investigating and bring-**  
18 **ing to resolution complaints about boards, commissions, task forces**  
19 **and work groups; and**

20 **“(f) Any other information the Governor determines is warranted**  
21 **for inclusion in the report.**

22 **“(3) The report shall include:**

1       “(a) Recommendations on how to identify and reduce fragmenta-  
2       tion, duplication and redundancy among existing boards and commis-  
3       sions;

4       “(b) A review of currently existing boards, commissions, task forces  
5       and work groups that identifies opportunities to conclude work, com-  
6       bine missions or consolidate agencies; and

7       “(c) Recommendations on procedures for establishing a periodic and  
8       ongoing review of boards, commissions, task forces and work groups  
9       to ensure retention of those entities for which a demonstrated need  
10      continues to exist.

11      “(4) In preparing the report described in subsection (1) of this sec-  
12      tion, the Governor shall consult with the President of the Senate, the  
13      Speaker of the House of Representatives, the co-chairs of the Ways  
14      and Means Subcommittee on General Government and the Secretary  
15      of State, or their designees.

16      “(5) After making the report described in subsection (1) of this  
17      section, the Governor may make supplemental findings and recom-  
18      mendations to the Legislative Assembly at any time, concerning the  
19      use of boards, commissions, task forces and work groups.

20      “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2,  
21      2017.”.
