

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2620**

1 Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Assembly finds that regional and**
3 **community based problem solving requires that state agencies:**

4 **“(a) Work more collaboratively and in an integrated fashion with**
5 **local governments, businesses and nonprofit corporations at the re-**
6 **gional and community level.**

7 **“(b) Align state investments and technical assistance with priorities**
8 **established at the regional and community level.**

9 **“(c) Maximize state services that are delivered at the regional and**
10 **community level.**

11 **“(d) Minimize expenditures that do not provide direct services to**
12 **Oregonians.**

13 **“(e) Use regional solution centers and regional solution teams to:**

14 **“(A) Support regional and community based mechanisms that in-**
15 **tegrate state and local resources and services; and**

16 **“(B) Engage private partners in problem solving.**

17 **“(f) Identify reforms that will advance the goals of reducing dupli-**
18 **cation, the fragmentation of functions and costs to communities.**

19 **“(g) Utilize principles developed by state agencies to improve service**
20 **delivery within available resources and in an innovative fashion.**

21 **“(2) The Governor, in coordination with the Director of the Oregon**
22 **Department of Administrative Services, shall develop a plan to align**

1 state economic and community development programs with regional
2 and community based development programs. The plan must propose
3 changes in state programs that promote regional and community
4 based problem solving as described in subsection (1) of this section
5 while preserving state program objectives and the delivery of services
6 by those programs.

7 “(3) The plan required under subsection (2) of this section is not
8 subject to the rulemaking requirements of ORS chapter 183, but the
9 Governor shall provide an opportunity for public review and engage-
10 ment in developing the plan. The plan shall be submitted to the
11 Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly for consideration during the
12 2014 regular session.

13 “(4) The Governor shall ensure that representatives of natural re-
14 source agencies participate in regional solution teams and are avail-
15 able at regional solution centers provided for in subsection (1)(e) of
16 this section to the maximum extent possible.”.
