

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 796**

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, delete lines 20 through 45 and insert:

2 “(a) Provide proof of completion of a training course described in para-
3 graph (b)(B) of this subsection and proof of completion of a firing range test
4 given as part of the course in which the person received a score of at least
5 70 percent on a maximum of three attempts, using a National Rifle Associ-
6 ation B27 or similar silhouette target, and the test consisted of the following
7 course of fire:

8 “(A) 20 rounds fired from a distance of three yards;

9 “(B) 20 rounds fired from a distance of seven yards; and

10 “(C) 10 rounds fired from a distance of 15 yards; or

11 “(b) Provide proof of:

12 “(A) Completion of a firing range test supervised by a firearms instructor
13 certified by the National Rifle Association or a law enforcement agency; and

14 “(B) One of the following:

15 “(i) Completion of any hunter education or hunter safety course approved
16 by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife or a similar agency of another
17 state if handgun safety was a component of the course;

18 “(ii) Completion of any National Rifle Association firearms safety or
19 training course if handgun safety was a component of the course;

20 “(iii) Completion of any firearms safety or training course or class avail-
21 able to the general public offered by law enforcement, community college,
22 or private or public institution or organization or firearms training school

1 utilizing instructors certified by the National Rifle Association or a law
2 enforcement agency if handgun safety was a component of the course;

3 “(iv) Completion of any law enforcement firearms safety or training
4 course or class offered for security guards, investigators, reserve law
5 enforcement officers or any other law enforcement officers if handgun safety
6 was a component of the course;

7 “(v) Equivalent experience with a handgun through participation in or-
8 ganized shooting competition or military service;

9 “(vi) That the person is licensed or has been licensed to carry a firearm
10 in this state, unless the license has been revoked; or

11 “(vii) Completion of any firearms training or safety course or class con-
12 ducted by a firearms instructor certified by a law enforcement agency or the
13 National Rifle Association if handgun safety was a component of the
14 course.”.

15 On page 6, delete lines 1 through 11.

16 On page 10, delete lines 12 through 45 and insert:

17 “(a) Provide proof of completion of a training course described in para-
18 graph (b)(B) of this subsection and proof of completion of a firing range test
19 given as part of the course in which the person received a score of at least
20 70 percent on a maximum of three attempts, using a National Rifle Associ-
21 ation B27 or similar silhouette target, and the test consisted of the following
22 course of fire:

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24 “(B) 20 rounds fired from a distance of seven yards; and

25 “(C) 10 rounds fired from a distance of 15 yards; or

26 “(b) Provide proof of:

27 “(A) Completion of a firing range test supervised by a firearms instructor

29 “(B) One of the following:

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17 in this state, unless the license has been revoked; or

18 “(vii) Completion of any firearms training or safety course or class con-
19 ducted by a firearms instructor certified by a law enforcement agency or the
20 National Rifle Association if handgun safety was a component of the course.

21 **“SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 166.291 by sections 1 and 2**
22 **of this 2013 Act apply only to applications for concealed handgun li-**
23 **censes submitted on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.”.**

24 On page 11, delete lines 1 through 3.

25 In line 4, delete “3” and insert “4”.

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
