

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 189**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 21 through 35 and insert:

2 “(5) If the director finds that a violation of subsection (1)(d), (i), (j) or (k)  
3 of this section has occurred, the director may issue an order under ORS  
4 chapter 183 disqualifying, for up to seven years after the date that the dis-  
5 qualification becomes effective:

6 “(a) The dealer whose license is revoked from:

7 “(A) Obtaining a license as a manufactured structure dealer; or

8 “(B) Working in an administrative or managerial capacity for a manu-  
9 factured structure dealer.

10 “(b) Any other person whose acts or omissions were material to the events  
11 that were the basis for the violation from working in an administrative or  
12 managerial capacity for a manufactured structure dealer.

13 “(6) If a person who is subject to disqualification or who is disqualified  
14 under subsection (5) of this section elects to pay restitution to a customer  
15 whom the director finds suffered harm as a result of the violation of sub-  
16 section (1)(d), (i), (j) or (k) of this section, the director may choose not to  
17 issue an order of disqualification to the person or may rescind a previously  
18 issued order of disqualification.”.
