

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3149**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 31.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Community College Child Care**
4 **Services is established.**

5 **“(2) The task force consists of members appointed as follows:**

6 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from**
7 **among members of the Senate.**

8 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one**
9 **member from among members of the House of Representatives.**

10 **“(c) The Commissioner for Community College Services shall ap-**
11 **point members who represent community college administrators,**
12 **community college faculty, community college students, the board of**
13 **education of a community college district, advocates for community**
14 **colleges, advocates for students in post-secondary education, the De-**
15 **partment of Community Colleges and Workforce Development and the**
16 **Child Care Division of the Employment Department. At least two**
17 **members of the task force must be community college faculty and at**
18 **least two members of the task force must be community college stu-**
19 **dents.**

20 **“(3) When selecting members of the task force as provided by sub-**
21 **section (2)(c) of this section, the Commissioner for Community College**
22 **Services shall:**

1 “(a) Consult with any applicable employee associations to solicit
2 recommendations for persons who are full-time community college
3 faculty and persons who are part-time community college faculty.

4 “(b) Consult with duly organized and recognized entities of student
5 government to solicit recommendations for persons who are commu-
6 nity college students.

7 “(4) The task force shall:

8 “(a) Study the cost of providing child care services to students of
9 community colleges; and

10 “(b) Identify sources for funding the cost of providing child care
11 services to students of community colleges.

12 “(5) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task
13 force are nonvoting members of the task force and may act in an ad-
14 visory capacity only.

15 “(6) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes
16 a quorum for the transaction of business.

17 “(7) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a
18 majority of the voting members of the task force.

19 “(8) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as
20 chairperson.

21 “(9) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority
22 shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.

23 “(10) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the
24 call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the
25 task force.

26 “(11) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation
27 of the task force.

28 “(12) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recom-
29 mendations for legislation, to the interim legislative committees on
30 education no later than September 1, 2014.

1 **“(13) The Department of Community Colleges and Workforce De-**
2 **velopment shall provide staff support to the task force.**

3 **“(14) Notwithstanding ORS 171.072, members of the task force who**
4 **are members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to mileage**
5 **expenses or a per diem and serve as volunteers on the task force.**
6 **Other members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or**
7 **reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

8 **“(15) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**
9 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties**
10 **and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to**
11 **furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
12 **consider necessary to perform their duties.”.**
