

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3407**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 11, after “represent” insert
2 “traditional” and after “workers” delete the rest of the line.

3 In line 12, delete “licensed by this state”.

4 In line 17, delete “State Board of Higher Education” and insert “Depart-
5 ment of Community Colleges and Workforce Development”.

6 In line 23, delete “community health worker”.

7 In line 24, delete “community” and insert “traditional”.

8 In line 28, delete “community” and insert “traditional”.

9 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:

10 “(3) In appointing members under subsection (2) of this section, the di-
11 rector shall consider whether the composition of the Traditional Health
12 Workers Commission represents the geographic, ethnic, gender, racial, disa-
13 bility status, gender identity, sexual orientation and economic diversity of
14 traditional health workers.”.

15 Delete lines 25 through 45 and delete page 3 and insert:

16 “**SECTION 4.** ORS 414.665 is amended to read:

17 “414.665. [(1) *The Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with the ap-*
18 *propriate health professional regulatory boards as defined in ORS 676.160 and*
19 *advocacy groups, shall develop and establish with respect to community health*
20 *workers, personal health navigators, peer wellness specialists and other health*
21 *care workers who are not regulated or certified by this state:]*

22 “(1) **In consultation with the Traditional Health Workers Commis-**

1 **sion, the Oregon Health Authority, for purposes related to the regu-**
2 **lation of community health workers, personal health navigators, peer**
3 **wellness specialists and doulas, shall adopt by rule:**

4 “(a) The criteria and descriptions of such individuals that may be utilized
5 by coordinated care organizations; [*and*]

6 “(b) Education and training requirements for such individuals[.];

7 **“(c) Appropriate professional designations for supervisors of such**
8 **individuals; and**

9 **“(d) Processes by which other occupational classifications may be**
10 **approved to supervise such individuals.**

11 “(2) The criteria and requirements established under subsection (1) of this
12 section:

13 “(a) Must be broad enough to encompass the potential unique needs of
14 any coordinated care organization;

15 “(b) Must meet requirements of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid
16 Services to qualify for federal financial participation; and

17 “(c) May not require certification by the Home Care Commission.”.

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
