PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2559

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "proceedings" insert a period and delete the rest of the line and lines 3 and 4.
- Delete lines 6 through 29 and delete pages 2 through 16 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 107.
- "SECTION 2. (1) If a judgment of marital annulment, dissolution or separation includes an order of spousal support, upon written request received from the other party, a party shall provide copies of the following documents to the requesting party for the purpose of determining whether there has been a substantial change in economic circumstances and a modification of the order of spousal support is appropriate, or for the purpose of entering into a stipulated modification:
- 14 "(a) The first and second pages of a party's most recently filed state 15 and federal income tax returns; and
- "(b) If the party has not filed income tax returns for the last calendar year, all W-2 statements, year-end payroll statements, interest and dividend statements and all other records of income earned or received by the party during the last calendar year.
- 20 "(2) A written request under this section may be made once every two years.

"(3) The written request under this section may be made without

the filing of a request for modification with the court.

"(4) A party providing documents under this section may redact all account numbers and personal identifying information from the documents provided except for the name of the party.

"(5) When a party requests documents under this section, the requesting party shall simultaneously provide copies of the requesting party's documents to the nonrequesting party. If the requesting party does not provide copies of the requesting party's documents, the nonrequesting party is not required to provide the requested documents to the requesting party."
