

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3035**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “amending ORS 184.483” and
2 insert “and declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2, and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency**
5 **Oregon Advisory Commission shall develop a plan for providing the**
6 **following information, or providing links to the following information,**
7 **on the Oregon transparency website:**

8 **“(a) Information on expenditures made by state agencies under**
9 **contracts, including the text of the contracts and information on the**
10 **work to be performed, or products or services to be provided, under**
11 **the contracts.**

12 **“(b) Information regarding the terms of state agency contracts that**
13 **is listed by categories, such as contracts not yet completed and antic-**
14 **ipated completion dates, in a manner that allows persons accessing the**
15 **website to search each category separately.**

16 **“(c) Information regarding vendors and other contractors under**
17 **state agency contracts that is listed by categories, such as city, state**
18 **and zip code of a vendor’s or contractor’s residence, in a manner that**
19 **allows persons accessing the website to search each category sepa-**
20 **rately.**

21 **“(d) Findings or determinations under ORS 279B.030 and 279B.036,**
22 **and supporting documentation for those findings or determinations.**

1 “(e) Annual revenue, annual expenditures and contracting and
2 subcontracting information for school districts and community col-
3 leges.

4 “(2) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advi-
5 sory Commission shall develop a plan for regularly updating the in-
6 formation on the Oregon transparency website in a manner that
7 promotes the goal of accuracy.

8 “(3) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advi-
9 sory Commission shall develop a long term vision and plan for the
10 Oregon transparency website, with an emphasis on ease of use.

11 “(4) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advi-
12 sory Commission shall report to the Legislative Assembly, in the
13 manner provided in ORS 192.245, the details of the plans developed
14 under this section.

15 “SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
16 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
17 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
