- 14 "(i) Parties identified by the agency as likely to be affected by the 15 rule.
- 16 "(ii) Persons on the advisory committee appointed pursuant to 17 subsection (1) of this section.
- 18 **"(B) Consider all reasonably available and relevant scientific**19 **studies.**
- "(b) A rule described in this subsection is not valid if the agency has not complied with the requirements described in paragraph (a) of this subsection prior to giving notice of its intended action under ORS

- "(3)(a) In order to resolve disputes and to address the rights of parties that engage in recreational or small scale mining, an agency shall, at least 30 days before issuing an order pursuant to ORS 468B.050 pertaining to recreational or small scale mining:
- 6 "(A) Consult with the following regarding the proposed order:
- 7 "(i) Parties identified by the agency as likely to be affected by the 8 order.
  - "(ii) Persons on the advisory committee appointed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.
  - "(B) Consider all reasonably available and relevant scientific studies.
  - "(b) An order described in this subsection is not valid if the agency has not complied with the requirements described in paragraph (a) of this subsection.".
