

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3260**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 9, delete “primary” and insert
2 “health”.

3 In line 14, delete “primary” and insert “health”.

4 In line 16, after “Includes” insert “effective”.

5 In line 17, delete “consumer” and insert “person”.

6 In line 22, delete “Integrates” and insert “Includes”.

7 After line 22, insert:

8 “(r) Provides equitable access to health care, according to a person’s
9 needs.

10 “(s) Is affordable for individuals, families, businesses and society.”.

11 In line 23, after “(2)” insert “To the extent practicable using only the
12 funds received under section 2 of this 2013 Act,”.

13 Delete lines 26 through 30 and insert:

14 “(a) An option for a publicly financed single-payer model for financing
15 privately delivered health care, that is decoupled from employment and al-
16 lows commercial insurance coverage only of supplemental health services not
17 paid for under the option.

18 “(b) An option that allows a person to choose between a publicly funded
19 plan, including a basic health program under 42 U.S.C. 18051, and pri-”.

20 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 11 and insert:

21 “(d) An option for a plan that provides essential health benefits, including
22 preventive care and hospital services, and that:

1 “(A) Is funded by a broad based and constitutionally dedicated sales tax
2 that does not tax income or payroll;

3 “(B) Allows a person to access the commercial market to purchase cov-
4 erage that is not covered under the plan;

5 “(C) Limits the role of the plan to collecting and distributing revenue
6 while preserving private sector delivery options and optimizing consumer
7 choice;

8 “(D) Offers to Oregonians who earn more than 400 percent of the federal
9 poverty guidelines a deductible plan that could be contributed to by em-
10 ployees and employers;

11 “(E) Exempts Oregonians who earn no more than 400 percent of the fed-
12 eral poverty guidelines from deductibles;

13 “(F) Accesses all sources of available federal funding; and

14 “(G) Identifies program savings that can be achieved by providing health
15 care coverage to all Oregonians, including but not limited to using the pro-
16 gram to replace the state medical assistance program and the medical portion
17 of worker’s compensation, then applies the savings to finance the plan.”.

18 In line 12, after “researchers” insert “conducting the study”.

19 In line 37, delete “and”.

20 In line 38, delete the period and insert: “; and

21 “(F) Estimates the potential savings to local governments and government
22 agencies that currently administer health care programs, provide health care
23 premium subsidies or provide funding for health care services.”.

24 In line 41, after the semicolon insert “and”.

25 Delete lines 42 through 45.

26 On page 3, line 1, delete “(d)” and insert “(b)”.

27 In line 2, after “care” insert a period and delete the rest of the line.

28 In line 3, delete “solicit” and insert “accept”.

29 After line 16, insert:

30 **SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2013 Act are repealed on Jan-**

1 **uary 2, 2016.”.**

2 In line 17, delete “4” and insert “5”.

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
