## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 136

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after "drugs" insert a period and 2 delete the rest of the line.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete <u>page 2</u> and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
5 of ORS 678.245 to 678.285.

6 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1)(a) Subject to paragraph (b) of this subsection, the 7 Oregon State Board of Nursing may authorize a certified registered 8 nurse anesthetist to prescribe prescription drugs, including pre-9 scriptions for controlled substances listed in Schedules II, III, III N, 10 IV and V.

"(b) A certified registered nurse anesthetist may prescribe pre scription drugs under paragraph (a) of this subsection only:

13 "(A) For a supply of not more than 10 days with no refills; and

"(B) For an individual for whom the certified registered nurse
 anesthetist has, at the time of the prescription, established a client
 or patient record.

"(2) For the purpose of authorizing certified registered nurse
 anesthetists to prescribe prescription drugs, the board shall adopt
 rules establishing:

20 "(a) That the scope of practice of a certified registered nurse 21 anesthetist includes the authority to prescribe prescription drugs.

22 "(b) Educational requirements for certified registered nurse

anesthetists applying for the authority to prescribe prescription drugs.
 Educational requirements adopted under this subsection must include:

3 "(A) At least 45 contact hours in pharmacology; and

4 "(B) Clinical education in pharmacotherapeutics, including man5 agement of patients that is congruent with the specialty role sought.

6 "(c) The form and manner of applying for and renewing the au-7 thority to prescribe prescription drugs.

8 "(d) Application and renewal fees.

9 "(e) Record keeping requirements for certified registered nurse 10 anesthetists who prescribe prescription drugs that are the same as the 11 record keeping requirements for pharmacies licensed under ORS 12 chapter 689.

"(3) In accordance with ORS chapter 183, the board may deny, sus pend or revoke the authority to prescribe prescription drugs under this
 section if the board finds that a certified registered nurse anesthetist
 has abused the authority.

17 "SECTION 3. Nothing in section 2 of this 2013 Act affects the au-18 thority of a certified registered nurse anesthetist, as defined in ORS 19 678.245, to select, order and administer controlled substances in con-10 nection with the delivery of anesthesia services. A certified registered 11 nurse anesthetist may obtain and renew certification with the Oregon 12 State Board of Nursing without prescriptive authority.".

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
