PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 846

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete <u>pages</u> 2 <u>2 and 3</u> and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'northeastern Oregon'
 means Morrow, Umatilla, Union and Wallowa Counties.

5 "(2) The Water Resources Department shall establish a storage, 6 conservation and in-stream flow protection and augmentation program 7 for the Umatilla Basin to increase in-stream and out-of-stream water 8 supplies in northeastern Oregon and to provide department services 9 as a liaison between parties wishing to engage in water-related trans-10 actions in the basin that may affect water supplies in northeastern 11 Oregon.

"(3) The department shall develop the program in a manner that is
 designed to increase water supplies in northeastern Oregon through
 the utilization of Columbia River water for in-stream and out-of stream uses within the basin and in a manner that:

16 "(a) Promotes agricultural development and production;

17 "(b) Is technically, economically and environmentally feasible;

18 "(c) Protects in-stream flow needs for native fish species;

"(d) Promotes regional partnerships between state and local gov ernments and nonprofit organizations;

21 "(e) Promotes public-private partnerships;

22 "(f) Promotes instream and out-of-stream water development

1 projects;

"(g) Benefits the state through the integration and coordination of
 programs; and

"(h) Limits new appropriations of live flow to the annual period
beginning October 1 and ending April 14 and to the extent that the
department determines that water is available during that period.

"(4) Measures for developing water resources in the basin under the
program may include, but need not be limited to:

9 "(a) Activities to support basin aquifer recovery projects;

10 "(b) The repair of dams and other facilities;

11 "(c) The development of new storage reservoirs;

12 "(d) Investments in water conservation measures;

13 "(e) The restoration and protection of streamflows; and

"(f) Engaging in discussions with the States of Washington and Idaho to identify possible avenues for interstate cooperation with regard to Columbia River water utilization and joint investments in winter water storage and in-stream and out-of-stream water development projects that have the potential to increase in-stream and outof-stream water supplies in northeastern Oregon.

20 "SECTION 2. For the biennium ending July 1, 2015, the Water Re-21 sources Department shall dedicate at least one full-time employee to 22 help implement the program described in section 1 of this 2013 Act in 23 a manner that is consistent with Consensus Options for Developing 24 Additional Storage Capacity identified in the Columbia River-Umatilla 25 Solutions Taskforce Declaration of Cooperation created in February 26 2013.

27 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Water Resources Department shall design the 28 program required under section 1 of this 2013 Act to increase in-stream 29 and out-of-stream water supplies and provide department liaison ser-30 vices for water-related transactions in a manner that is consistent

- "SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2013 Act is repealed on June 30,
 2015.".
