

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 794**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line
2 and insert “creating new provisions; and amending ORS 475.304.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 20 and insert:

5 **“RECIPROCITY**

7 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
8 of ORS 475.300 to 475.346.**

9 **“SECTION 2. A person who is a resident of another state and who
10 possesses less than one ounce of marijuana is excepted from the
11 criminal laws of this state for possession, delivery or production of
12 marijuana, for aiding and abetting another in the possession, delivery
13 or production of marijuana or for any other criminal offense in which
14 possession, delivery or production of marijuana is an element, if the
15 person is authorized to engage in the medical use of marijuana in the
16 person’s state of residence.**

18 **“GROW SITE REGISTRY**

19
20 **“SECTION 3. ORS 475.304 is amended to read:**

21 **“475.304. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish by rule a
22 marijuana grow site registration system to authorize production of marijuana**

1 by a registry identification cardholder, a designated primary caregiver who
2 grows marijuana for the cardholder or a person who is responsible for a
3 marijuana grow site. The marijuana grow site registration system adopted
4 must require a registry identification cardholder, **if the registry identifi-**
5 **cation cardholder elects to produce or have another person produce**
6 **marijuana for the registry identification cardholder**, to submit an ap-
7 plication to the authority that includes:

8 “(a) The name of the person responsible for the marijuana grow site;

9 “(b) The address of the marijuana grow site;

10 “(c) The registry identification card number of the registry cardholder for
11 whom the marijuana is being produced; and

12 “(d) Any other information the authority considers necessary.

13 “(2) The authority shall issue a marijuana grow site registration card to
14 a registry identification cardholder who has met the requirements of sub-
15 section (1) of this section.

16 “(3) A person who has been issued a marijuana grow site registration card
17 under this section must display the registration card at the marijuana grow
18 site at all times when marijuana is being produced.

19 “(4) A marijuana grow site registration card must be obtained and posted
20 for each registry identification cardholder for whom marijuana is being
21 produced at a marijuana grow site.

22 “(5) All usable marijuana, plants, seedlings and seeds associated with the
23 production of marijuana for a registry identification cardholder by a person
24 responsible for a marijuana grow site are the property of the registry iden-
25 tification cardholder and must be provided to the registry identification
26 cardholder upon request.

27 “(6)(a) The authority shall conduct a criminal records check under ORS
28 181.534 of any person whose name is submitted as a person responsible for
29 a marijuana grow site.

30 “(b) A person convicted of a Class A or Class B felony under ORS 475.752

1 to 475.920 for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance in
2 Schedule I or Schedule II may not be issued a marijuana grow site registra-
3 tion card or produce marijuana for a registry identification cardholder for
4 five years from the date of conviction.

5 “(c) A person convicted more than once of a Class A or Class B felony
6 under ORS 475.752 to 475.920 for the manufacture or delivery of a controlled
7 substance in Schedule I or Schedule II may not be issued a marijuana grow
8 site registration card or produce marijuana for a registry identification
9 cardholder.

10 “(7) A registry identification cardholder or the designated primary
11 caregiver of the cardholder may reimburse the person responsible for a
12 marijuana grow site for the costs of supplies and utilities associated with the
13 production of marijuana for the registry identification cardholder. No other
14 costs associated with the production of marijuana for the registry identifi-
15 cation cardholder, including the cost of labor, may be reimbursed.

16 “(8) The authority may adopt rules imposing a fee in an amount estab-
17 lished by the authority for registration of a marijuana grow site under this
18 section.
