- In line 6 of the printed bill, delete "painting the vehicle a solid color,".
- 2 After line 8, insert:

- "SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part
 of the Oregon Vehicle Code.
- "SECTION 3. (1) A person commits the offense of operating an impostor police vehicle if the person operates a motor vehicle on a highway or premises open to the public and the vehicle is painted in a manner that resembles a vehicle used by a police officer.
- 9 "(2) This section does not apply to:
- "(a) Persons using vehicles described in subsection (1) of this section exclusively for movie or television production;
- 12 "(b) Employees of law enforcement agencies, as defined in ORS 13 136.595, acting within the scope of their employment;
- "(c) Persons test-driving vehicles to facilitate repair or maintenance of the vehicles or installation or removal of police vehicle equipment on or from the vehicles;
- 17 "(d) Vehicle dealers in possession of new police vehicles for pur-18 poses of sale or display; or
- "(e) Companies that sell or offer for sale police vehicles or police vehicle equipment, for the purpose of test-driving the vehicles or demonstrating the equipment.
 - "(3) The offense described in this section, operating an impostor

police vehicle, is a Class A traffic violation.".
