

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2443**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “and” and insert a comma and  
2 after “471.282” insert “and 471.360”.

3 On page 9, after line 39, insert:

4 **“SECTION 9.** ORS 471.360, as amended by section 2, chapter 54, Oregon  
5 Laws 2012, is amended to read:

6 “471.360. (1) Except as otherwise provided in ORS 471.375:

7 “(a) Any person employed by a licensee of the Oregon Liquor Control  
8 Commission [*who*] **must have a valid service permit issued by the com-**  
9 **mission if the person:**

10 **“(A)** Participates in any manner in the mixing, selling or service of al-  
11 coholic liquor for consumption on the premises where served or sold [*shall*  
12 *have a valid service permit issued by the commission.*]; **or**

13 **“(B) Participates in the dispensing of malt beverages, wines or cider**  
14 **sold in securely covered containers provided by the consumer.**

15 “(b) A licensee of the commission may not permit any person **who lacks**  
16 **a service permit required of the person under paragraph (a) of this**  
17 **subsection:**

18 **“(A)** To mix, sell or serve any alcoholic liquor for consumption on li-  
19 censed premises [*unless the person has a valid service permit issued by the*  
20 *commission.*]; **or**

21 **“(B) To dispense malt beverages, wines or cider sold in securely**  
22 **covered containers provided by the consumer.**

1       “(c) A permittee shall make the service permit available at any time while  
2 on duty for immediate inspection by any liquor enforcement inspector or by  
3 any other peace officer.

4       “(2) The commission may waive the requirement for a service permit for  
5 an employee of a licensee whose primary function is not the sale of alcoholic  
6 liquor or food, including but not limited to public passenger carriers, hospi-  
7 tals, or convalescent, nursing or retirement homes.”.
