- On page 6, line 6, delete the period and insert a semicolon.
- Delete lines 9 and 10 and insert "on-site, including food and beverages:
- "(A) Required to be made available in conjunction with the consumption
- of wine on the premises by the Liquor Control Act or rules adopted under
- the Liquor Control Act; or
- "(B) Served in conjunction with an activity authorized by paragraph (b)
- or (d) of this subsection;".
- In line 11, delete "private" and insert "agri-tourism or other
- 19 commercial".
- 20 On page 7, delete lines 23 and 24 and insert:
- "(12) When a bed and breakfast facility, as defined in ORS 624.010, is sited
- 22 as a home occupation on the same tract as a winery established under this
- 23 section and is in association with the winery:
- "(a) The bed and breakfast facility may prepare and serve any meals for
- 25 a maximum of 18 patrons; and
- 26 "(b) Meals prepared at the bed and breakfast facility for a maximum of

- 28 "(13) As used in this section:
- 29 "(a) 'Agri-tourism or other commercial events' includes outdoor concerts
- 30 for which admission is charged, educational, cultural, health or lifestyle

- events, facility rentals, celebratory gatherings and other events at which the
- 2 promotion of wine produced in conjunction with the winery is a secondary
- 3 purpose of the event.
- "(b) 'On-site retail sale' includes the retail sale of wine in person at the winery site, through a wine club or over the Internet or telephone.
- **"SECTION 7.** ORS 624.010 is amended to read:
- 624.010. As used in ORS 624.010 to 624.121, unless the context requires otherwise:
- 9 "(1) 'Authority' means the Oregon Health Authority.
- "(2) 'Bed and breakfast facility' means any establishment located in a structure designed for a single family residence and structures appurtenant thereto, regardless of whether the owner or operator of the establishment resides in any of the structures, that:
- "(a) Has more than two rooms for rent on a daily basis to the public; and
- 15 "(b) Offers [a breakfast] meal **service as provided in ORS 624.046** as part of the cost of the room.
- "(3) 'Director' means the Director of the Oregon Health Authority.
- "(4) 'Intermittent temporary restaurant' means an establishment:
- "(a) That operates temporarily at a specific location in connection with multiple public gatherings, entertainment events, food product promotions or other events, at least two of which are arranged for by different oversight organizations; and
 - "(b) Where food is prepared or served for consumption by the public.
- "(5) 'Limited service restaurant' means a restaurant serving only individually portioned prepackaged foods prepared from an approved source by a commercial processor and nonperishable beverages.
- "(6) 'Operational review' means the examination of a plan of operation for an establishment in order to ensure that the proposed operation conforms with applicable sanitation standards.
- "(7) 'Oversight organization' means an entity responsible for organizing,

- managing or otherwise arranging for a public gathering, entertainment 1
- event, food product promotion or other event, including but not limited to 2
- ensuring the availability of water, sewer and sanitation services. 3
- "(8) 'Restaurant,' except as provided in subsection (9) of this section, 4 means an establishment:
- "(a) Where food or drink is prepared for consumption by the public; 6
- "(b) Where the public obtains food or drink so prepared in form or 7
- quantity consumable then and there, whether or not it is consumed within 8
- the confines of the premises where prepared; or 9
- "(c) That prepares food or drink in consumable form for service outside 10 the premises where prepared. 11
- "(9) 'Restaurant' does not mean a railroad dining car, bed and breakfast 12 facility, intermittent temporary restaurant, seasonal temporary restaurant 13
- or single-event temporary restaurant. 14

- "(10) 'Seasonal temporary restaurant' means an establishment: 15
- "(a) That operates at a specific location in connection with multiple 16
- public gatherings, entertainment events, food product promotions or other 17
- events that are arranged for by the same oversight organization; and 18
- "(b) Where food is prepared or served for consumption by the public. 19
- "(11) 'Single-event temporary restaurant' means an establishment: 20
- "(a) That operates in connection with a single public gathering, enter-21 tainment event, food product promotion or other event; and 22
- "(b) Where food is prepared or served for consumption by the public. 23
- **"SECTION 8.** ORS 624.046 is amended to read: 24
- "624.046. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall allow a bed and breakfast 25
- facility to conduct food service operations for its patrons in rooms used by 26
- the owner or operator[, *provided that:*] 27
- "[(1) Such rooms are not used as sleeping quarters; and] 28
- "[(2) Persons not employed by the facility shall be excluded from such 29
- rooms during breakfast meal hours.] if the rooms in which food service 30

- 1 operations are conducted:
- 2 "(a) Are not used as sleeping quarters; and
- "(b) Are off-limits during meal hours to individuals not employed
 by the bed and breakfast facility.
- "(2) Except as provided in ORS 215.452 or 215.453, meal service in a bed and breakfast facility is limited to the preparation and service of breakfast.".
