

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2355**

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 461.549 is amended to read:

3 “461.549. (1) The Legislative Assembly finds that emotional and behavioral
4 problems related to gambling may impose additional costs on state govern-
5 ment and on the state economy, such as additional mental health expendi-
6 tures, increased law enforcement costs and lost economic output. The use of
7 a portion of the net receipts from video lottery games to pay the costs of
8 preventing and treating emotional and behavioral problems related to gam-
9 bling promotes the creation of jobs and this state’s economic development
10 by offsetting and treating the negative economic consequences of such be-
11 havior.

12 “[*(2) In each fiscal quarter, commencing with the fiscal quarter beginning*
13 *July 1, 2001, there is allocated from the Administrative Services Economic*
14 *Development Fund to the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund established by*
15 *ORS 413.522 an amount of not less than one percent of the moneys transferred*
16 *from the State Lottery Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Devel-*
17 *opment Fund during that fiscal quarter.]*

18 **“(2) In each fiscal quarter of a biennium, commencing with the fifth**
19 **fiscal quarter of the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, there is allocated**
20 **from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the**
21 **Problem Gambling Treatment Fund established by ORS 413.522 an**
22 **amount equal to the greater of:**

1 **“(a) One percent of the moneys transferred from the Oregon State**
2 **Lottery Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Development**
3 **Fund in that fiscal quarter; or**

4 **“(b) One percent of the moneys transferred from the Oregon State**
5 **Lottery Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Development**
6 **Fund during the same fiscal quarter of the biennium beginning July**
7 **1, 2011.”.**

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
