

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 148**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 12 and 13 and insert:

2 “(k) A copy of the applicant’s criminal records check.”.

3 On page 3, delete lines 3 through 8 and insert:

4 “(6)(a) A chief petitioner shall ensure that a criminal records check is  
5 conducted for each applicant seeking registration under this section to de-  
6 termine whether the applicant has been convicted of any of the crimes de-  
7 scribed in subsection (4)(a) of this section, or was subject to any of the  
8 penalties described in subsection (4)(b) and (c) of this section.

9 “(b) The secretary by rule shall prescribe the scope of the criminal re-  
10 cords check to be performed pursuant to this subsection. The applicant’s  
11 criminal records check may be conducted by either the chief petitioner or the  
12 applicant.

13 “(c) An applicant seeking registration under this section is required to  
14 have only one criminal records check conducted for each period beginning  
15 the day after a biennial general election and ending on the day of the next  
16 biennial general election.”.
