"18.300. [In accordance with section 522(b) of the Bankruptcy Code of 1978
(11 U.S.C. 522(b)), residents of this state shall not be entitled to the federal
exemptions provided in section 522(d) of the Bankruptcy Code of 1978 (11
U.S.C. 522(d)). Nothing in this section shall affect the exemptions given to
residents of this state by the Constitution of the State of Oregon and the
Oregon Revised Statutes.]

"(1) For purposes of a bankruptcy petition, a resident of this state
may use the federal exemptions provided in section 522(d) of the
Bankruptcy Code of 1978 (11 U.S.C. 522(d)) or the exemptions given to
residents of this state under state law, but may not use both.

(2)(a) If a resident of this state uses any of the federal exemptions 13 provided in section 522(d) of the Bankruptcy Code of 1978 (11 U.S.C. 14 522(d)) for purposes of a bankruptcy petition, the resident may not use 15any of the exemptions given to residents of this state under state law. 16 "(b) If a resident of this state uses any of the exemptions given to 17 residents of this state under state law for purposes of a bankruptcy 18 petition, the resident may not use any of the federal exemptions pro-19 vided in section 522(d) of the Bankruptcy Code of 1978 (11 U.S.C. 20522(d)). 21

22 "(3) This section does not apply to executions.".
