- 3 "329.805. (1) Subject to ORS 291.232 to 291.260, the Department of Educa-
- 4 tion shall distribute grants-in-aid to qualifying school districts to offset the
- 5 costs of beginning teacher and administrator mentorship programs. [A qual-
- 6 ifying district shall receive annually up to \$5,000 for each full-time equivalent
- 7 beginning teacher and administrator approved for support. Each biennium, the
- 8 department shall adjust the amount specified for each teacher or administrator
- 9 based on the Consumer Price Index, as defined in ORS 327.006.]
- "(2) If the funds are insufficient for all eligible proposals, the Department of Education shall award grants on a competitive basis, taking into consid-
- 12 eration geographic and demographic diversity.
- 13 "(3) The State Board of Education may adopt such rules as it considers 14 appropriate for the distribution of grants-in-aid under this section.
- 15 "(4) A district that is determined by the Department of Education to be 16 in violation of one or more of the requirements of ORS 329.788 to 329.820
- may be required to refund all grants-in-aid moneys distributed under ORS
- 18 329.788 to 329.820. The amount of penalty shall be determined by the State
- 19 Board of Education.".
