

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2005**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 40 through 45 and
2 delete page 3 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 5.** ORS 455.140 is amended to read:

4 “455.140. (1) There is established a Mechanical Board consisting of
5 [*nine*] **10** members appointed by the Governor.

6 “(2) The members of the board shall assist the Director of the Department
7 of Consumer and Business Services in administering the code adopted pur-
8 suant to ORS 455.020 for mechanical devices and equipment.

9 “(3) The board must consist of:

10 “(a) One representative of the plumbing industry;

11 “(b) One sheet metal and air conditioner contractor;

12 “(c) One municipal mechanical inspector possessing the highest level of
13 mechanical inspector certification issued by the Department of Consumer
14 and Business Services;

15 “(d) One heating, venting and air conditioning contractor;

16 “(e) One heating, venting and air conditioning installer;

17 “(f) One sheet metal and air conditioner installer;

18 “(g) One representative of a natural gas company or other utility;

19 “(h) One building official; [*and*]

20 **“(i) One insulation craftsman who has experience with heat and
21 frost insulation; and**

22 “[*i*] (j) One public member who does not receive compensation from any

1 interest represented under paragraphs (a) to [(h)] (i) of this subsection.

2 “(4) At least one of the board members described in subsection (3)(b) or
3 (d) of this section must be an owner or operator of a contracting business
4 employing 10 or fewer persons at the time of the member’s appointment to
5 the term.

6 **“SECTION 6. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is repealed January 2, 2015.**

7 **“SECTION 7. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
8 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
9 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
