

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO
B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2101**

1 On page 17 of the printed B-engrossed bill, after line 14, insert:

2 **“SECTION 30a. If House Bill 2102 becomes law, section 30 of this**
3 **2013 Act (amending ORS 688.720) is repealed and ORS 688.720, as**
4 **amended by section 19, chapter 43, Oregon Laws 2012, and section 2,**
5 **chapter 62, Oregon Laws 2013 (Enrolled House Bill 2102), is amended**
6 **to read:**

7 “688.720. (1) The Oregon Health Licensing Agency shall issue a registra-
8 tion as an athletic trainer under ORS 688.701 to 688.734 to an applicant who
9 has:

10 “(a) Provided to the [*Board of Athletic Trainers*] **agency** adequate proof
11 of:

12 “(A) Receipt of a bachelor’s degree from an accredited four-year college
13 or university and having met the minimum athletic training curriculum re-
14 quirements established by the Board **of Athletic Trainers** by rule; or

15 “(B) Military experience or training that the board determines is sub-
16 stantially equivalent to the education required by subparagraph (A) of this
17 paragraph;

18 “(b) Successfully completed the certification examination administered by
19 the national Board of Certification, or an equivalent examination approved
20 by the Board of Athletic Trainers;

21 “(c) Completed any other requirements for registration as determined by
22 the Board **of Athletic Trainers** by rule;

1 “(d) Submitted to the [*board*] **agency** adequate documentation that the
2 applicant is at least 18 years of age; and

3 “(e) Paid [*all fees required*] **the applicable fees** for registration **estab-**
4 **lished under section 4 of this 2013 Act.**

5 “(2) The agency shall issue a registration under this section to an appli-
6 cant who has not successfully completed an examination under subsection (1)
7 of this section if the applicant:

8 “(a) Furnishes documentation that demonstrates that the applicant meets
9 the education, experience or training requirements described in subsection
10 (1)(a) of this section; and

11 “(b) Is registered as an athletic trainer in another state or by a national
12 association and the board determines that the registration requirements of
13 the other state or the association are substantially equivalent to the regis-
14 tration requirements described in subsection (1)(c) of this section.”.

15 On page 35, after line 22, insert:

16 “**SECTION 65a. Notwithstanding section 8, chapter 82, Oregon Laws**
17 **2013 (Enrolled Senate Bill 107) (amending ORS 694.185), if Senate Bill**
18 **107 becomes law, ORS 694.185 is repealed by section 65 of this 2013**
19 **Act.”.**
