

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2118**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest  
2 of the line and delete line 3 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) There is created a nine-member health plan quality  
5 metrics work group, consisting of:**

6 **“(a) One member appointed by the executive director of the Oregon  
7 Health Insurance Exchange Corporation;**

8 **“(b) One member appointed by the Oregon Health Authority;**

9 **“(c) One member appointed by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board;**

10 **“(d) One member appointed by the Public Employees’ Benefit  
11 Board; and**

12 **“(e) Five members appointed by the executive director of the  
13 Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation, in consultation with  
14 the Director of the Oregon Health Authority, the Oregon Educators  
15 Benefit Board and the Public Employees’ Benefit Board, including:**

16 **“(A) One individual with expertise in health care research;**

17 **“(B) One individual with expertise in health care quality measures;**

18 **“(C) One representative of insurers;**

19 **“(D) One representative of consumers of health care; and**

20 **“(E) One representative of a self-insured large employer.**

21 **“(2)(a) The work group shall publish recommendations for appro-  
22 priate health outcomes and quality measures to be used by the corpo-**

1 ration, the authority and the boards. In developing the measures, the  
2 work group shall consider other state and national health outcomes  
3 and quality measures and methodologies.

4 “(b) To the extent practicable, the work group shall recommend  
5 measures that further the goals of the Oregon Integrated and Coordi-  
6 nated Health Care Delivery System while recognizing the unique needs  
7 and goals of the corporation, the authority and the boards.

8 “(3) The work group shall utilize available health outcomes and  
9 quality measures and the data systems for reporting the measures and  
10 minimize redundant reporting or the reporting of data with limited  
11 value.

12 “(4) The work group shall develop a common format for collecting  
13 consumer responses to the health quality measures and encourage the  
14 corporation, the authority and the boards to publicly report the  
15 findings.

16 “(5)(a) The work group shall report its progress to the regular ses-  
17 sion of the 2014 Legislative Assembly.

18 “(b) No later than May 31, 2014, the work group shall provide to the  
19 appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly a final  
20 report of the work group’s recommendations and any steps taken by  
21 the corporation, the authority and the boards to implement the rec-  
22 ommendations.

23 “(6) The corporation shall provide staff support for the work group.

24 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed upon the con-  
25 vening of the 2015 regular session of the Legislative Assembly.

26 “SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate  
27 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
28 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.”.

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
