

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2656**

1 On page 6 of the printed bill, delete line 9 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 14. (1) For the two-year period beginning on the effective**
3 **date of this 2013 Act, moneys described in subsection (2) of this section**
4 **shall be used by the Oregon Tourism Commission, in consultation with**
5 **the Governor’s Office of Film and Television, to promote tourism in**
6 **rural areas in Oregon through film and video. Moneys may be used**
7 **under this subsection for reasonable travel expenses related to the**
8 **production of film and video to promote tourism in rural areas in**
9 **Oregon.**

10 **“(2) Subsection (1) of this section applies to the greater of:**

11 **“(a) Amounts of state transient lodging taxes that would not have**
12 **been collected but for the enhanced administration and enforcement**
13 **of existing transient lodging tax law effected by the amendments to**
14 **ORS 320.300, 320.305, 320.310, 320.315, 320.320, 320.325 and 320.330 by**
15 **sections 3 to 9 of this 2013 Act, after payment of refunds and re-**
16 **imbursement of the Department of Revenue pursuant to ORS 320.335;**
17 **or**

18 **“(b) \$600,000.**

19 **“(3) Not later than December 1, 2015, the commission shall submit**
20 **a report, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to an interim com-**
21 **mittee of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development**
22 **detailing the commission’s activities pursuant to this section.**

1 **“(4) As used in this section, ‘rural area’ means an area located en-**
2 **tirely outside the acknowledged Portland Metropolitan Area Regional**
3 **Urban Growth Boundary and the acknowledged urban growth bound-**
4 **aries of cities with populations of 100,000 or more.**

5 **“SECTION 15. (1) Section 2 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January**
6 **2, 2023.**

7 **“(2) Section 14 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2017.”.**

8 In line 10, delete “15” and insert “16”.
