PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2311

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 31 and insert: 2 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 184.621 is amended to read:

"184.621. The Oregon Transportation Commission shall work with 3 stakeholders to review and update the criteria used to select projects within 4 the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program. When revising the $\mathbf{5}$ project selection criteria the commission shall consider whether the project: 6 "(1) Improves the state highway system or major access routes to the state 7 highway system on the local road system to relieve congestion by expanding 8 capacity, enhancing operations or otherwise improving travel times within 9 high-congestion corridors. 10

"(2) Enhances the safety of the traveling public by decreasing traffic crash rates[, promoting the efficient movement of people and goods and preserving the public investment in the transportation system].

"[(3) Increases the operational effectiveness and reliability of the existing
system by using technological innovation, providing linkages to other existing
components of the transportation system and relieving congestion.]

"[(4) Is capable of being implemented to reduce the need for additional
highway projects.]

"[(5)] (3) Improves the condition, connectivity and capacity of freight reliant infrastructure serving the state.

21 "[(6)] (4) Supports improvements necessary for this state's economic 22 growth and competitiveness, accessibility to industries and economic devel1 opment.

² "[(7)] (5) Provides the greatest benefit in relation to project costs.

³ "(6) Reduces emissions from motor vehicles.

4 "(7) Improves connectivity between different modes of transporta5 tion.

6 "[(8) Fosters livable communities by demonstrating that the investment does 7 not undermine sustainable urban development.]

8 "[(9) Enhances the value of transportation projects through designs and 9 development that reflect environmental stewardship and community 10 sensitivity.]

11 "[(10) Is consistent with the state's greenhouse gas emissions reduction 12 goals and reduces this state's dependence on foreign oil.]".

13
