

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3523**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “ORS” insert “260.039,
2 260.042.”.

3 On page 6, line 19, delete “and number”.

4 On page 9, delete lines 1 through 12 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 8.** ORS 260.039 is amended to read:

6 “260.039. (1) Except as provided in ORS 260.043, a candidate who serves
7 as the candidate’s own treasurer, or the treasurer of the principal campaign
8 committee, shall file a statement of organization with the filing officer. The
9 statement shall include:

10 “(a) The name, address, occupation, office sought and party affiliation of
11 the candidate. The address shall be the address of a residence, office, head-
12 quarters or similar location where the candidate may be conveniently lo-
13 cated.

14 “(b) In the case of a principal campaign committee:

15 “(A) The name and address of the committee. The address shall be the
16 address of a residence, office, headquarters or similar location where the
17 political committee or a responsible officer of the political committee may
18 be conveniently located.

19 “(B) The name, address and occupation of the committee director or di-
20 rectors, if any.

21 “(C) The name and address of the committee treasurer.

22 “(D) The name and address of any other political committee of which two

1 or more committee directors are also directors of the committee filing the
2 statement.

3 “(c) The name of the financial institution in which the campaign account
4 required under ORS 260.054 is established, the name [*and number*] of the
5 account, the name of the account holder and the names of all individuals
6 who have signature authority for the account. The Secretary of State may
7 not disclose information received by the secretary under this paragraph ex-
8 cept as necessary for purposes of enforcing the provisions of ORS chapters
9 246 to 260.

10 “(2) A candidate or treasurer may designate an individual to receive any
11 notice provided by a filing officer under ORS chapters 246 to 260. The can-
12 didate or treasurer shall include the name and address of the individual in
13 the statement of organization filed under this section. A filing officer who
14 provides any notice under ORS chapters 246 to 260 to the candidate or
15 treasurer shall also provide the notice to the individual designated by the
16 candidate or treasurer under this subsection.

17 “(3) Except as provided in ORS 260.043, a candidate who serves as the
18 candidate’s own treasurer shall file the statement of organization not later
19 than the third business day after the candidate first receives a contribution
20 or makes an expenditure. The treasurer of a principal campaign committee
21 shall file the statement of organization not later than the date specified in
22 ORS 260.035.

23 “(4) Any change in information submitted in a statement of organization
24 under subsection (1) of this section shall be indicated in an amended state-
25 ment of organization filed not later than the 10th day after the change in
26 information.

27 “(5) Except as provided in ORS 260.043, a candidate who serves as the
28 candidate’s own treasurer or the treasurer of the principal campaign com-
29 mittee of the candidate shall file a statement of organization under this
30 section not later than the deadline for the candidate to file a nominating

1 petition or declaration of candidacy under ORS 249.037 or a certificate of
2 nomination under ORS 249.722.

3 “(6) Except as provided in ORS 260.043, a candidate who serves as the
4 candidate’s own treasurer or the treasurer of the principal campaign com-
5 mittee of a candidate shall file a new or amended statement of organization
6 not later than the date that the candidate files a nominating petition, dec-
7 laration of candidacy or certificate of nomination.

8 **“SECTION 9.** ORS 260.042 is amended to read:

9 “260.042. (1) The treasurer of a political committee shall file a statement
10 of organization with the filing officer. The statement shall include:

11 “(a) The name, address and nature of the committee. The address shall
12 be the address of a residence, office, headquarters or similar location where
13 the political committee or a responsible officer of the political committee
14 may be conveniently located.

15 “(b) The name, address and occupation of the committee director or di-
16 rectors.

17 “(c) The name and address of the committee treasurer.

18 “(d) The name and address of any other political committee of which two
19 or more committee directors are also directors of the committee filing the
20 statement.

21 “(e) The name, office sought, and party affiliation of each candidate whom
22 the committee is supporting or specifically opposing or intends to support
23 or specifically oppose, when known, or, if the committee is supporting or
24 specifically opposing all the candidates of a given party, the name of that
25 party.

26 “(f) A designation of any measure that the committee is opposing or sup-
27 porting, or intends to support or oppose.

28 “(g) The name of the financial institution in which the campaign account
29 required under ORS 260.054 is established, the name [*and number*] of the
30 account, the name of the account holder and the names of all individuals

1 who have signature authority for the account. The Secretary of State may
2 not disclose information received by the secretary under this paragraph ex-
3 cept as necessary for purposes of enforcing the provisions of ORS chapters
4 246 to 260.

5 “(h) A statement of whether the committee is a controlled committee.

6 “(2) A treasurer may designate an individual to receive any notice pro-
7 vided by a filing officer under ORS chapters 246 to 260. The treasurer shall
8 include the name and address of the individual in a statement of organization
9 filed under this section. A filing officer who provides any notice under ORS
10 chapters 246 to 260 to the treasurer of the political committee shall also
11 provide the notice to the individual designated by the treasurer under this
12 subsection.

13 “(3) The statement of organization shall be filed not later than the date
14 specified in ORS 260.035.

15 “(4) Any change in information submitted in a statement of organization
16 under subsection (1) of this section shall be indicated in an amended state-
17 ment of organization filed not later than the 10th day after the change in
18 information.

19 “(5) This section does not apply to a political committee that is a princi-
20 pal campaign committee or to a political committee exclusively supporting
21 or opposing one or more candidates for federal or political party office.

22 **“SECTION 10. Section 7 of this 2013 Act and the amendments to**
23 **ORS 260.039, 260.042, 260.044, 260.057, 260.083, 260.118 and 260.232 by**
24 **sections 1 to 5, 8 and 9 of this 2013 Act become operative on September**
25 **19, 2013.**

26 **“SECTION 11. (1) Section 7 of this 2013 Act and the amendments to**
27 **ORS 260.039, 260.042, 260.044, 260.057, 260.083, 260.118 and 260.232 by**
28 **sections 1 to 5, 8 and 9 of this 2013 Act apply to contributions received,**
29 **expenditures made and statements of independent expenditures re-**
30 **quired to be filed on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**

1 **“(2) The Secretary of State may take any action before the opera-**
2 **tive date specified in section 10 of this 2013 Act that is necessary to**
3 **enable the secretary to exercise, on and after the operative date spec-**
4 **ified in section 10 of this 2013 Act, all of the duties, functions and**
5 **powers conferred upon the secretary by section 7 of this 2013 Act and**
6 **the amendments to ORS 260.039, 260.042, 260.044, 260.057, 260.083, 260.118**
7 **and 260.232 by sections 1 to 5, 8 and 9 of this 2013 Act.”.**

8 In line 13, delete “10” and insert “12”.

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
