## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 683

- On page 1 of the printed corrected A-engrossed bill, delete lines 5 through 2 22.
- On page 2, delete lines 1 through 12 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 441.098 is amended to read:
- 5 "441.098. (1) As used in this section and sections 2 and 3 of this 2013 6 Act:
- 7 "(a) 'Facility' means a hospital, outpatient clinic owned by a hospital,
- 8 ambulatory surgical center, [or] freestanding birthing center or facility that
- 9 receives Medicare reimbursement as an independent diagnostic testing
- 10 facility.

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- "(b) 'Financial interest' means a five percent or greater direct or indirect ownership interest.
- "(c)(A) 'Health practitioner' means a physician, podiatric physician and surgeon, dentist, direct entry midwife, [or] licensed registered nurse who is
- 15 certified by the Oregon State Board of Nursing as a nurse midwife nurse
- 16 practitioner, certified nurse practitioner, licensed physician assistant
- or medical imaging licensee under ORS 688.405 to 688.605.
  - "(B) 'Health practitioner' does not include a provider in a health maintenance organization as defined in ORS 750.005.
- 20 "(d) 'Physician' has the meaning given that term in ORS 677.010.
- "(2) A health practitioner's decision to refer a patient to a facility for a diagnostic test or health care treatment or service shall be based

- on the patient's clinical needs and personal health choices.
- "[(2)] (3) If a health practitioner refers a patient for a diagnostic test
- 3 or health care treatment or service at a facility in which the health prac-
- 4 titioner or an immediate family member of the health practitioner has a
- 5 financial interest, the health practitioner or the practitioner's designee
- 6 shall inform the patient orally and in writing of that interest at the time of
- 7 the referral.
- 8 "(4)(a) If a health practitioner refers a patient to a facility for a
- 9 diagnostic test or health care treatment or service, the health practi-
- 10 tioner or the practitioner's designee shall inform the patient, in the
- 11 form and manner prescribed by the Oregon Health Authority by rule,
- 12 **that:**
- 13 "(A) The patient may receive the test, treatment or service at a
- 14 different facility of the patient's choice; and
- 15 "(B) If the patient chooses a different facility, the patient should
- 16 contact the patient's insurer regarding the extent of coverage or the
- 17 limitations on coverage for the test, treatment or service at the facil-
- 18 ity chosen by the patient.
- 19 "(b) Rules concerning the form and manner for informing a patient
- 20 as required by this subsection shall:
- 21 "(A) Be designed to ensure that the information is conveyed in a
- 22 timely and meaningful manner;
- 23 "(B) Be administratively simple; and
- "(C) Accommodate a provider's adoption and use of electronic
- 25 health record systems.
- 26 "(5) A health practitioner may not deny, limit or withdraw a refer-
- 27 ral to a facility solely for the reason that the patient chooses to obtain
- 28 the test, treatment or service from a different facility.
- 29 "(6) The authority may not impose additional restrictions or limi-
- 30 tations on any referral described in this section that are in addition

- to the requirements specified in subsections (3) and (4) of this section.
- "[(3)] (7) In obtaining informed consent for a diagnostic test or health
- 3 care treatment or service that will take place at a facility, a health prac-
- 4 titioner shall disclose the manner in which care will be provided in the event
- 5 that complications occur that require health services beyond what the facil-
- 6 ity has the capability to provide.

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- "(8) Subsections (3) to (5) of this section do not apply to a referral for a diagnostic test or health care treatment or service:
- "(a) For a patient who is receiving inpatient hospital services or services in an emergency department if the referral is for a diagnostic test or health care treatment or service to be performed while the patient is in the hospital or emergency department;
- "(b) Made to a particular facility after the initial referral of the patient to that facility; or
- 15 "(c) Made by the facility or provider to whom a patient was re-16 ferred.".
- In line 13, delete "the provisions of".
- In line 14, after "441.098" insert "(2), (3), (4) or (5)".
- Delete lines 19 through 22 and insert:
  - "SECTION 3. If the Oregon Health Licensing Agency or the appropriate health professional regulatory board takes disciplinary action under section 2 of this 2013 Act, the agency or board may also impose a civil penalty of not more than \$1,000 on a health practitioner for violating ORS 441.098 (2), (3), (4) or (5)."

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
