

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 789**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “provisions;” delete the rest
2 of the line and insert “amending ORS 243.252; and repealing ORS 243.886 and
3 section 16, chapter 7, Oregon Laws 2007.”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2013 Act are added to and
6 made a part of ORS 243.860 to 243.886.**

7 **“SECTION 2. (1)(a) A community college district may not provide
8 or contract for a benefit plan unless the benefit plan is provided and
9 administered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board under ORS
10 243.860 to 243.886.**

11 **“(b) Eligible employees of a community college district may partic-
12 ipate only in benefit plans provided and administered by the board.**

13 **“(2) Except for community college districts, a district may provide
14 or contract for benefit plans provided and administered by the Oregon
15 Educators Benefit Board or the district may provide or contract for
16 benefit plans other than benefit plans provided and administered by
17 the board.**

18 **“(3) Eligible employees of districts other than community college
19 districts may participate in benefit plans provided and administered
20 by the board or benefit plans provided or contracted for by a district.**

21 **“SECTION 3. A district that offers a benefit plan provided and ad-
22 ministered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board may not offer a**

1 **benefit plan other than a benefit plan provided and administered by**
2 **the board until the expiration of the benefit plan provided and ad-**
3 **ministered by the board.**

4 **“SECTION 4.** ORS 243.252 is amended to read:

5 “243.252. (1) The state may pay none of the cost of making health benefit
6 plan coverage available to a retired state employee who is an eligible em-
7 ployee and to family members or may agree, by collective bargaining agree-
8 ment or otherwise, to pay part or all of that cost.

9 “(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section or other law[, *except ORS*
10 *243.886,*] prohibits a collective bargaining unit from agreeing with an em-
11 ployer that is a public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, to establish a retiree
12 medical trust, voluntary employees’ beneficiary association, health re-
13 imbursement arrangement or other agreement for health care expenses of
14 employees or retirees if the provisions of the trust, association, arrangement
15 or other agreement comply with the requirements of the Insurance Code.

16 **“SECTION 5. (1) ORS 243.886 is repealed.**

17 **“(2) Section 16, chapter 7, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section**
18 **7, chapter 39, Oregon Laws 2008, is repealed.”.**
