

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2644**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, ‘public education**
4 **program’ means an education program provided by any of the follow-**
5 **ing:**

6 **“(a) A school district;**

7 **“(b) A public charter school;**

8 **“(c) An education service district;**

9 **“(d) A long term care or treatment facility, as described in ORS**
10 **343.961;**

11 **“(e) The Youth Corrections Education Program; or**

12 **“(f) The Oregon School for the Deaf.**

13 **“(2) For each school year, the Department of Education shall re-**
14 **quire public education programs to submit the following information**
15 **about students in kindergarten through grade 12 classes:**

16 **“(a) The total number of students in the classes; and**

17 **“(b) The total number of licensed or registered teachers regularly**
18 **assigned to the students counted under paragraph (a) of this sub-**
19 **section.**

20 **“(3) By February 1 of the year following the school year described**
21 **in subsection (2) of this section, the Department of Education shall**
22 **make the information received under subsection (2) of this section**

1 available to:

2 “(a) The public on the website of the Department of Education; and

3 “(b) The Legislative Assembly through annual reports.

4 “(4) For the purpose of this section, the State Board of Education
5 shall identify by rule:

6 “(a) The definition of what constitutes a class for which a public
7 education program must report;

8 “(b) The definition of what constitutes regular assignment of
9 teachers to students for purposes of subsection (2)(b) of this section;

10 “(c) The categories of classes for which a public education program
11 must report; and

12 “(d) If possible, the source of an existing data set that may be used
13 to satisfy the requirements of this section.

14 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act first applies to information
15 submitted by public education programs for the 2014-2015 school
16 year.”.

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
