

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3528**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest
2 of the line and insert “creating new provisions; amending ORS 171.745; and
3 declaring an emergency.”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 171.745 is amended to read:

6 “171.745. (1) A lobbyist registered with the Oregon Government Ethics
7 Commission or required to register with the commission shall, according to
8 the schedule described in ORS 171.752, file with the commission a statement
9 showing for the applicable reporting period:

10 “(a) The total amount of all moneys expended for food, refreshments and
11 entertainment by the lobbyist for the purpose of lobbying.

12 “(b) The name of any legislative **official** or executive official to whom
13 or for whose benefit, on any one occasion, an expenditure is made for the
14 purposes of lobbying, and the date, name of payee, purpose and amount of
15 that expenditure. This paragraph applies if the total amount expended on the
16 occasion by one or more persons exceeds \$50.

17 “(2) Statements required by this section need not include:

18 **“(a)** Amounts expended by the lobbyist for personal living and travel ex-
19 penses and office overhead, including salaries and wages paid for staff and
20 secretarial assistance, and maintenance expenses[.]; **or**

21 **“(b) Amounts expended by the lobbyist on lobbying another lobbyist**
22 **who is registered with the commission or required to register with the**

1 **commission, or on lobbying any person on whose behalf a lobbyist is**
2 **registered or required to register. This paragraph does not apply if the**
3 **person lobbied is a legislative official, an executive official or a mem-**
4 **ber of a state board or commission.**

5 “(3) If the amount of any expenditure required to be included in a state-
6 ment is not accurately known at the time the statement is required to be
7 filed, an estimate of the expenditure shall be submitted in the statement and
8 designated as an estimate. The exact amount expended for which a previous
9 estimate was made shall be submitted in a subsequent report when the in-
10 formation is available.

11 “[3] (4) A statement required by this section shall include a copy of any
12 notice provided to a public official or candidate under ORS 244.100.

13 “[4] (5) For each statement required by this section, an entity
14 [*comprised*] **composed** of more than one lobbyist may file one statement that
15 reports expenditures by the entity and not by individual lobbyists.

16 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 171.745, as amended by section 1 of this 2013 Act, is
17 amended to read:

18 “171.745. (1) A lobbyist registered with the Oregon Government Ethics
19 Commission or required to register with the commission shall, according to
20 the schedule described in ORS 171.752, file with the commission a statement
21 showing for the applicable reporting period:

22 “(a) The total amount of all moneys expended for food, refreshments and
23 entertainment by the lobbyist for the purpose of lobbying.

24 “(b) The name of any legislative official or executive official to whom or
25 for whose benefit, on any one occasion, an expenditure is made for the pur-
26 poses of lobbying, and the date, name of payee, purpose and amount of that
27 expenditure. This paragraph applies if the total amount expended on the oc-
28 casion by one or more persons exceeds \$50.

29 “(2) Statements required by this section need not include[:]

30 “[a)] amounts expended by the lobbyist for personal living and travel

1 expenses and office overhead, including salaries and wages paid for staff and
2 secretarial assistance, and maintenance expenses. [; or]

3 *“(b) Amounts expended by the lobbyist on lobbying another lobbyist who
4 is registered with the commission or required to register with the commission,
5 or on lobbying any person on whose behalf a lobbyist is registered or required
6 to register. This paragraph does not apply if the person lobbied is a legislative
7 official, an executive official or a member of a state board or commission.]*

8 “(3) If the amount of any expenditure required to be included in a state-
9 ment is not accurately known at the time the statement is required to be
10 filed, an estimate of the expenditure shall be submitted in the statement and
11 designated as an estimate. The exact amount expended for which a previous
12 estimate was made shall be submitted in a subsequent report when the in-
13 formation is available.

14 “(4) A statement required by this section shall include a copy of any no-
15 tice provided to a public official or candidate under ORS 244.100.

16 “(5) For each statement required by this section, an entity composed of
17 more than one lobbyist may file one statement that reports expenditures by
18 the entity and not by individual lobbyists.

19 **“SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 171.745 by section 2 of this
20 2013 Act become operative on June 30, 2015.**

21 **“SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
22 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
23 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
