

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2305**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the
2 rest of the line and delete line 3 and insert “declaring an emergency; and
3 providing for revenue estimate modification that requires approval by a
4 two-thirds majority.”.

5 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

6 **“SECTION 1. Pursuant to Article IX, section 14 (6)(a), of the Oregon**
7 **Constitution, the Legislative Assembly increases the amount of the**
8 **estimate of revenues that will be received from corporate income and**
9 **excise taxes for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, to \$995,000,000.**

10 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**
11 **any positive difference between the actual amount of revenues col-**
12 **lected from corporate income and excise taxes for the biennium be-**
13 **ginning July 1, 2011, and the estimate made for that biennium**
14 **pursuant to Article IX, section 14 (1), of the Oregon Constitution, shall**
15 **be deposited in the Community College Support Fund established un-**
16 **der ORS 341.620.**

17 **“(2) If the actual amount of revenues collected from corporate in-**
18 **come and excise taxes for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, exceeds**
19 **the amount of the estimate made in section 1 of this 2013 Act by two**
20 **percent or more:**

21 **“(a) The difference between the actual amount of revenues and the**
22 **estimate made in section 1 of this 2013 Act shall be returned to cor-**

1 porate income and excise taxpayers in the manner provided in ORS
2 291.349; and

3 “(b) The difference between the estimate of revenues made in sec-
4 tion 1 of this 2013 Act and the estimate made for the biennium begin-
5 ning July 1, 2011, pursuant to Article IX, section 14 (1), of the Oregon
6 Constitution, shall be deposited in the Community College Support
7 Fund established under ORS 341.620.

8 “SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
9 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
10 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
