(1) Whenever any policy of health insurance provides for re-<sup>4</sup> imbursement for any service which is within the lawful scope of practice of <sup>5</sup> a [*duly licensed and*] certified nurse practitioner, including prescribing or <sup>6</sup> dispensing drugs, the insured under the policy is entitled to reimbursement <sup>7</sup> for such service whether it is performed by a physician licensed by the <sup>8</sup> Oregon Medical Board or by a [*duly licensed*] **certified** nurse practitioner.

"(2) A health insurer that, on or after January 1, 2009, reduced the 9 reimbursement rates that it pays for services performed by certified 10 nurse practitioners to be below the rates paid before January 1, 2009, 11 shall file with the Department of Consumer and Business Services, in 12the form and manner prescribed by the department, a justification for 13 the reduction in rates. The department shall approve or disapprove the 14 justification according to criteria prescribed by the department by 15rule. If the department disapproves the justification filed by an 16 insurer, the insurer shall increase the reimbursement rates that it 17 pays for services performed by certified nurse practitioners to rates 18 that are equal to or above the highest rates paid prior to January 1, 19 2009. 20

"[(2)] (3) This section does not apply to group practice health maintenance organizations that are federally qualified pursuant to Title XIII of the
