PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 199

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete "536.050 and".
- Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. ORS 537.348, as amended by section 2, chapter 205, Oregon
- 4 Laws 2001, is amended to read:
- 5 "537.348. (1) Any person may purchase, or on a temporary or perma-
- 6 nent basis may lease or accept a gift of, [or lease] all or a portion of an
- 7 existing water right [or accept a gift of all or a portion of an existing water
- 8 right] for conversion to an in-stream water right. Any water right converted
- 9 to an in-stream water right under this section shall retain the priority date
- of the water right purchased, leased or received as a gift. [At the request of
- 11 the person the Water Resources Commission shall issue a new certificate for
- 12 the in-stream water right showing the original priority date of the purchased,
- 13 gifted or leased water right. A person who transfers a water right by purchase,
- 14 lease or gift under this subsection shall comply] Except as provided in
- subsections (4) to (6) of this section, a transfer under this section must
- 16 be in compliance with the requirements for the transfer of a water right
- 17 under ORS 540.505 to 540.585.
- "(2) Subject to subsections (3) to (8) of this section, any person who
- 19 has an existing water right may lease all or a portion of the existing water
- 20 right for use as an in-stream water right for a specified period without the
- loss of the original priority date. During the term of [such] the lease, the
- 22 use of the water right as an in-stream water right shall be considered a

- 1 beneficial use. The term of the lease may not exceed five years. There
- 2 is no limitation on the number of times that the lease may be renewed.
- "(3) A lease of all or a portion of an existing water right for use as
- 4 an in-stream water right under subsection (2) of this section may allow
- 5 the split use of the water between the existing water right and the
- 6 in-stream right during the same water or calendar year provided:
- 7 "(a) The uses are not concurrent; and
- 8 "(b) The holders of the water rights measure and report to the
- 9 Water Resources Department the use of the existing water right and
- 10 the in-stream water right.
- 11 "(4) A person who has an existing water right and wishes to lease
- 12 the water right as described in subsection (2) of this section may apply
- 13 for department approval of a temporary change of use for a period not
- 14 to exceed five years. An application for a change of use under this
- 15 section must:
- 16 "(a) Be submitted in writing to the department;
- 17 "(b) Be accompanied by the appropriate fee for an in-stream water
- 18 lease as set forth in ORS 536.050; and
- 19 **"(c) Include:**
- 20 "(A) The name of the owner;
- 21 "(B) The existing use of the water;
- 22 "(C) A description of the premises upon which the water is used
- 23 under the existing water right;
- 24 "(D) A description of the body of water in which it is proposed that
- 25 the leased water be used for an in-stream purpose;
- 26 "(E) The in-stream purpose proposed to be made of the leased wa-
- 27 **ter**;
- 28 "(F) Evidence that the water has been used over the past five years
- 29 according to the terms and conditions of the owner's water right cer-
- 30 tificate or that the water right is not subject to forfeiture under ORS

540.610; and

- 2 "(G) Any other information the Water Resources Commission by 3 rule may require.
- "(5) Notwithstanding any notice and waiting requirements under ORS 540.505 to 540.585, the department shall approve by order an application under subsection (4) of this section for a temporary change of use if the department determines that the temporary change of use will not injure any existing water right.
 - "(6) All uses of water for which a temporary change of use is approved under subsection (5) of this section shall revert automatically to the use described in the water right certificate upon expiration of the lease. Any renewal of the lease is subject to the filing of a new application under subsection (4) of this section and approval under subsection (5) of this section of the new application.
 - "(7) The time during which water is used under a temporary change of use approved under subsection (5) of this section does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
 - "(8) The department at any time may revoke or modify an order issued for a lease under subsection (2) of this section if the department determines that the use of the water right for in-stream use under the lease has resulted in or may result in injury to an existing water right.
 - "SECTION 2. ORS 537.348, as amended by section 2, chapter 205, Oregon Laws 2001, and section 1 of this 2013 Act, is amended to read:
 - "537.348. (1) Any person may purchase[, or on a temporary or permanent basis may lease or accept a gift of,] or lease all or a portion of an existing water right or accept a gift of all or a portion of an existing water right for conversion to an in-stream water right. Any water right converted to an in-stream water right under this section shall retain the priority date of the water right purchased, leased or received as a gift. [Except as provided in subsections (4) to (6) of this section, a transfer under this section must be in

- 1 compliance with the requirements for the transfer of a water right under ORS
- 2 540.505 to 540.585.] At the request of the person the Water Resources
- 3 Commission shall issue a new certificate for the in-stream water right
- 4 showing the original priority date of the purchased, gifted or leased
- 5 water right.
- 6 "(2) [Subject to subsections (3) to (8) of this section,] Any person who has
- 7 an existing water right may lease all or a portion of the existing water right
- 8 for use as an in-stream water right for a specified period without the loss
- 9 of the original priority date. During the term of the lease, the use of the
- water right as an in-stream water right shall be considered a beneficial use.
- 11 [The term of the lease may not exceed five years. There is no limitation on the
- 12 number of times that the lease may be renewed.]
 - "(3) A person who transfers a water right by purchase, lease or gift
 - under this section shall comply with the requirements for the transfer
- of a water right under ORS 540.505 to 540.585.
- "[(3) A lease of all or a portion of an existing water right for use as an
- in-stream water right under subsection (2) of this section may allow the split
- 18 use of the water between the existing water right and the in-stream right
- 19 during the same water or calendar year provided:]
- "[(a) The uses are not concurrent; and]
- 21 "[(b) The holders of the water rights measure and report to the Water Re-

- "[(C) A description of the premises upon which the water is used under the existing water right;]
- 6 "[(D) A description of the body of water in which it is proposed that the 7 leased water be used for an in-stream purpose;]
- 8 "[(E) The in-stream purpose proposed to be made of the leased water;]
- "[(F) Evidence that the water has been used over the past five years according to the terms and conditions of the owner's water right certificate or that the water right is not subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610; and]
- "[(G) Any other information the Water Resources Commission by rule may require.]
- "[(5) Notwithstanding any notice and waiting requirements under ORS 540.505 to 540.585, the department shall approve by order an application under subsection (4) of this section for a temporary change of use if the department determines that the temporary change of use will not injure any existing water right.]
- "[(6) All uses of water for which a temporary change of use is approved under subsection (5) of this section shall revert automatically to the use described in the water right certificate upon expiration of the lease. Any renewal of the lease is subject to the filing of a new application under subsection (4) of this section and approval under subsection (5) of this section of the new application.]
- "[(7) The time during which water is used under a change of use approved under subsection (5) of this section does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.]
- "[(8) The department at any time may revoke or modify an order issued for a lease under subsection (2) of this section if the department determines that the use of the water right for in-stream use under the lease has resulted in or

may result in injury to an existing water right.] 1

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- "SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 537.348 by section 2 of this 2 2013 Act become operative on January 2, 2020. 3
- "SECTION 4. Section 3, chapter 205, Oregon Laws 2001, as amended 4 by section 1, chapter 355, Oregon Laws 2007, is repealed. 5
- "SECTION 5. (1) The amendments to ORS 537.348 by section 1 of this 6 2013 Act apply to leases and lease renewals entered into on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
 - "(2) Notwithstanding the amendments to ORS 537.348 by section 2 of this 2013 Act, any lease or renewal allowing the split use of water between an existing water right and an in-stream water right during the same water or calendar year and having a term that began before the operative date of the amendments to ORS 537.348 by section 2 of this 2013 Act may continue in effect until the earlier of the expiration of the term or five years after the operative date of the amendments to ORS 537.348 by section 2 of this 2013 Act.".

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
