PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 21

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 6, delete "choice" and insert "individual choices".
- In line 7, delete "competent" and insert "responsive".
- In line 8, delete "in" and delete "cost effectiveness" and insert "costfectiveness".
- 6 Delete lines 12 through 17 and insert:
- 7 "Whereas health system transformation is changing the landscape of the
- 8 health care delivery system, and the long term care system is changing to
- 9 better coordinate health care and long term care services and supports; and
- "Whereas Oregon has an obligation and an opportunity to engage in bold and innovative planning to meet future demands and individual choices of seniors and people with disabilities; now, therefore,".
- Delete lines 19 through 29 and insert:

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- "SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall develop a plan to improve and strengthen Oregon's publicly funded long term care system. The plan shall explore:
 - "(1) Strategies to serve seniors and people with disabilities in their own homes and community settings of their own choosing;
- "(2) Strategies designed to support independence and delay the entry of individuals into publicly funded long term care;
- "(3) Strategies to serve individuals equitably in a culturally and linguistically responsive manner;

- "(4) Strategies to ensure that individuals currently served in publicly funded long term care are exempted or transitioned without the loss of benefits in any new initiatives proposed; and
- "(5) Strategies to use Medicaid demonstration projects to provide the greatest flexibility under federal requirements to administer long term care for seniors and people with disabilities.".

On page 2, delete lines 1 through 44 and insert:

- "SECTION 2. (1) To assist in developing the plan described in section 1 of this 2013 Act, the Department of Human Services shall convene a planning committee that includes representatives of all key stakeholders, including consumers, providers and consumer and provider groups representing seniors and people with disabilities.
- "(2) The department shall conduct public hearings in regions throughout this state.
- "(3) After considering input received in the public hearings, the department shall finalize the plan described in section 1 of this 2013 Act with the planning committee described in subsection (1) of this section and shall submit a written report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 during the 2014 regular session of the Legislative Assembly. The report must include a description of any federal approval that is required to secure federal matching funds for the expenses of implementing the plan.
- "(4) The department shall propose any legislative changes necessary to implement the plan described in section 1 of this 2013 Act in the manner provided in ORS 171.130.".

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
