

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2105**

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Energy shall review the**  
3 **following matters related to the Energy Facility Siting Council:**

4 **“(a) Means to encourage consistency between the standards for the**  
5 **siting of facilities of the federal government and local governments**  
6 **with those specified in ORS 469.300 to 469.563.**

7 **“(b) A mechanism to enhance the participation of local govern-**  
8 **ments during the facility siting process when the standards for the**  
9 **siting of facilities of local governments are consistent with those**  
10 **specified in ORS 469.300 to 469.563.**

11 **“(c) Means to encourage public participation in the design and sit-**  
12 **ing of facilities.**

13 **“(d) The definition of ‘energy facility’ specified in ORS 469.300 and**  
14 **recommendations to clarify the definition for purposes of determining**  
15 **which public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, has authority relating**  
16 **to the siting of facilities.**

17 **“(e) Means to ensure constructive and effective participation by lo-**  
18 **cal governments, state agencies and federally recognized Indian tribes**  
19 **in the siting of facilities.**

20 **“(f) Means to ensure the efficient and cost-effective recovery of fees**  
21 **expended in the review of applications for site certificates.**

22 **“(g) Any other matters deemed relevant by the department.**

1       **“(2) The department shall submit a report with the results of the**  
2 **study, and include recommendations for legislation, to the interim**  
3 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to environment and**  
4 **natural resources on or before November 1, 2013.**

5       **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2,**  
6 **2015.**

7       **“SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
8 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
9 **declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
