

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 127**

1 Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part**
3 **of ORS 480.315 to 480.385.**

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Declared state of emergency’ means:**

6 **“(A) A major disaster, as defined in 42 U.S.C. 5122 (2), declared by**
7 **the President of the United States;**

8 **“(B) A state of emergency declared by the Governor under ORS**
9 **401.165; or**

10 **“(C) A state of emergency declared by a city or county under ORS**
11 **401.309.**

12 **“(b) ‘Emergency services’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
13 **401.025.**

14 **“(c) ‘Generator drop’ means a mechanism that allows emergency**
15 **services providers to switch fuel dispensing devices from the usual**
16 **power source to a generator or other alternative power source so that**
17 **the devices may be operated during a declared state of emergency.**

18 **“(d) ‘Motor vehicle’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
19 **801.360.**

20 **“(2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, each motor vehicle fuel**
21 **dispensing device at a filling station, service station, garage, nonretail**
22 **facility or other dispensary of Class 1 flammable liquids or diesel fuel**

1 **must be linked to a generator drop. The State Fire Marshal shall adopt**
2 **rules establishing the minimum requirements for a generator drop.**
3 **The rules may include, but need not be limited to, requirements for**
4 **generator drops to have standardized fittings for connecting to alter-**
5 **native power sources and for generator drops to meet minimum per-**
6 **formance standards.**

7 **“(3) Subsection (2) of this section applies to a filling station, service**
8 **station, garage, nonretail facility or other dispensary that undergoes**
9 **fuel dispensing system construction or renovation commencing on or**
10 **after January 1, 2014. For purposes of this subsection, ‘construction**
11 **or renovation’ means the installation, replacement or substantial re-**
12 **pair of underground tanks, fuel supply lines, fuel dispensing devices**
13 **and other equipment as set forth by the State Fire Marshal by rule.**

14 **“(4) When adopting or amending rules under this section, the State**
15 **Fire Marshal shall consult with the Department of Consumer and**
16 **Business Services, the State Department of Energy and the Office of**
17 **Emergency Management.”.**
