- "SECTION 4. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is amended to read:
- "Sec. 1. (1) As used in this section:
- "(a) 'Education provider' means:
- 20 "(A) An entity that offers a program that is recognized as an Oregon
- prekindergarten program under ORS 329.170 to 329.200.
- 22 "(B) A school district board.

- "(b) 'Eye examination' means an eye examination that:
- 2 "(A) Is conducted by a person licensed by the Oregon Board of Optometry

Failure by a student to meet the requirements of this section may not result in a program's or school's prohibiting the student from attending the program or school, but may result in withholding report cards or similar actions.
- "(b) File in the student's vision health record any certifications and any results of a vision screening or an eye examination known by the education provider.
  - "(c) Provide the parent or guardian of each student with information about the vision screenings and eye examinations, and information about further examinations or necessary treatments.
  - "(5) The State Board of Education, in consultation with [the Oregon Education Investment Board and] the Oregon Health Policy Board, shall adopt by rule any standards for the implementation of this section.".
