PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 722

1 Delete lines 4 through 21 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>"SECTION 1.</u> (1) In an effort to reduce the burden of the human
papillomavirus and related cancers in this state, the Oregon Health
Authority shall prepare a human papillomavirus and comprehensive
related cancer control plan as an addendum to the Oregon Comprehensive Cancer Plan that assesses the following:

7 "(a) Existing disease prevention or surveillance policies and pro8 grams;

9 "(b) Existing disease prevention or surveillance measures;

10 "(c) Public and health care provider awareness;

"(d) Gaps in knowledge related to the human papillomavirus and
 related cancers; and

"(e) Opportunities to improve disease prevention and surveillance
 policies, programs and measures.

"(2) The plan must address, at a minimum, cervical cancer,
 anogenital cancer, oral cavity cancer and pharyngeal cancer.

"(3) The authority shall submit the plan, along with recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative
Assembly related to health on or before September 1, 2014.".
