## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 605

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "appropriating money" and insert "amending ORS 196.471".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:
- **"SECTION 1.** ORS 196.471 is amended to read:
- 5 "196.471. (1) The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall
- 6 review the Territorial Sea Plan and any subsequent amendments recom-
- 7 mended by the Ocean Policy Advisory Council to either the Territorial Sea
- 8 Plan or the Oregon Ocean Resources Management Plan and make findings
- 9 that the plan or amendments **recommended by the council**:
- "(a) Carry out the policies of ORS 196.405 to 196.515; and
- "(b) Are consistent with applicable statewide planning goals, with emphasis on the four coastal goals.
- "(2) After making the findings required by subsection (1) of this section,
- 14 the commission shall adopt the Territorial Sea Plan or proposed amendments
- as part of the Oregon Coastal Management Program.
- "(3) If the commission does not make the findings required by subsection
- 17 (1) of this section, the commission shall return the plan or amendments to
- the council for revision. The commission may specify any needed revisions.
- 19 If the council makes subsequent recommendations for amendments,
- 20 the council must:
- 21 "(a) Include the commission's specified revisions in the recommen-
- 22 dations; and

"(b) Make the subsequent recommendations for amendments within 155 days after the date that the commission returns the plan or amendments to the council for revision. The commission and the council may mutually agree to extend the time that the council is allowed under this subsection for submitting subsequent recommendations to the commission.

"(4) Upon adoption of the Territorial Sea Plan or subsequent amendments the commission may, after consultation with affected state agencies, identify amendments to agency ocean or coastal resource management programs necessary to conform to the provisions of the adopted plan.

"SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage."
