PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 360

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert "creating 2 new provisions; amending ORS 543.765;".

3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete <u>page 2</u> and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. ORS 543.765 is amended to read:

5 "543.765. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 537.145 and ORS chapter 543, the 6 holder of a water right may apply to the Water Resources Department for a 7 certificate to use water for hydroelectric purposes within an artificial deliv-8 ery system under the applicant's existing water right. If the proposed hy-9 droelectric project qualifies for a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission 10 exemption, the applicant may use the expedited application process under 11 this section.

"(2) An application, which shall be on a form provided by the department,
 for a hydroelectric certificate under this section must include:

"(a) The certificate number, or decree reference if no confirming certificate has been issued, of the applicant's existing water right associated with
the proposed hydroelectric project.

"(b) A copy of a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission exemption ap plication, if applicable.

"(c) A proposed schedule of annual water use and an estimate of the
 maximum power generation of the proposed hydroelectric project.

"(d) A statement by the applicant that the amount of water used by the proposed hydroelectric project will not exceed the amount authorized and

used under the applicant's existing water right for beneficial use without 1 waste. $\mathbf{2}$

"(e) A statement that the applicant owns or otherwise controls the water 3 conveyance system. 4

"(f) An application processing fee of \$500. The department shall deposit $\mathbf{5}$ fees collected under this section into the Water Resources Department Hy-6 droelectric Fund established pursuant to ORS 536.015. 7

"(g) A map or drawing and all other data concerning the proposed hy-8 droelectric project, as may be prescribed by the department. The map or 9 drawing must be of sufficient quality and scale to establish the location of 10 the existing point of diversion and the proposed location of the hydroelectric 11 facility. 12

"(h) If the water to be used for the proposed hydroelectric project is de-13 livered by a public entity other than the applicant for a certificate under this 14 section, a statement from that entity that the entity will be able to deliver 15 water as described in the application. 16

(i) Evidence that the water has been used over the past five years ac-17 cording to the terms and conditions of the applicant's existing water right 18 described in paragraph (a) of this subsection. 19

"(3) If an applicant provides the information required by subsection (2) 20of this section: 21

"(a) The Water Resources Department shall provide notice to both the 22State Department of Fish and Wildlife and the public, and provide a 30-day 23period for public comment. 24

"(b) The Water Resources Department may issue a final order and certif-25icate to use water for hydroelectric purposes upon making a final determi-26nation that the proposed hydroelectric use does not impair, or is not 27detrimental to, the public interest in the manner provided in ORS 537.170 (8). 28"(4) If the Water Resources Department determines that public interest 29 issues have been identified, the department shall issue a final order denying

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the application. The department shall also issue a final order denying the 1 application if the department identifies issues related to the public interest. $\mathbf{2}$ If the applicant does not appeal the final order as provided in ORS chapter 3 183 and, within one year of the department's final order denying the 4 applicant's application, files an application with the department for a pre- $\mathbf{5}$ liminary permit to operate a hydroelectric project as provided in ORS 537.130 6 and 543.210, the applicant shall receive a credit toward the applicant's ap-7 plication fees in the amount of \$500. 8

9 "(5) At a minimum, a certificate issued under this section must contain 10 the following conditions:

"(a) Fish screens[,] and by-pass devices [and fish passages] as required
by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

(b) Except as provided in this paragraph, fish passages as required by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife. If the application is for hydroelectric generating equipment that is to be installed in or on a conduit delivery system, the certificate does not need to include a requirement for fish passages at the diversion point for the conduit delivery system if:

19 "(A) The conduit delivery system is not on or in a dam structure;

"(B) The conduit system is operated for the distribution of water
 for agricultural, municipal or industrial consumption; and

"(C) Except as provided in subsection (15) of this section, the certificate includes a condition for the making of annual payments under
subsection (14) of this section.

"[(b)] (c) That use of water be limited to periods when the applicant's existing water right is put to beneficial use without waste and that the amount used is not greater than the quantity of water diverted to satisfy the authorized specific use under the existing water right described in subsection (2)(a) of this section.

((c)] (d) That use of water be limited by rate, duty, season and any other

limitations of the applicant's existing water right described in subsection
 (2)(a) of this section.

"[(d)] (e) That the applicant measure and report the quantity of water
diverted.

5 "[(e) Any other conditions the Water Resources Department deems necessary
6 to protect the public interest.]

"(f) That the restrictions established in ORS 543.660 shall apply as conditions of use to a certificate issued under this section to a district as defined in ORS 543.655.

"(g) That a certificate issued under this section shall be invalidated upon a change in the point of diversion of the existing water right described in subsection (2)(a) of this section.

"[(h) The Water Resources Department shall conduct a review of certificates
 issued under this section and shall issue a final order and a superseding cer tificate that corresponds to any changes or adjustments made to the applicant's
 existing water right described in subsection (2)(a) of this section.]

"[(i)] (h) That the right to use water under a certificate issued under this section is invalidated if the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission exemption related to the certificate is canceled or invalidated.

"(i) Any other conditions the Water Resources Department deems
 necessary to protect the public interest.

22 "(6) The Water Resources Department shall conduct a review of 23 certificates issued under this section and shall issue a final order and 24 a superseding certificate that corresponds to any changes or adjust-25 ments made to the applicant's existing water right described in sub-26 section (2)(a) of this section.

"(7) Subsection (5)(b) of this section does not affect any requirement for fish passage applicable to a project that is otherwise required
by law.

30 "(8) Upon request, the State Department of Fish and Wildlife and

the Water Resources Department will arrange a preapplication meeting with a person to discuss the fish supportive measure requirements associated with the installation of a hydroelectric project in an artificial delivery system.

5 "[(6)] (9) A certificate issued under this section may not have its own 6 priority date. The Water Resources Department may not regulate for or 7 against any certificate issued under this section based on the priority date 8 of the certificate.

9 "[(7)] (10) A certificate issued under this section does not grant a right 10 to divert water for hydroelectric purposes.

"[(8)] (11) A certificate issued under this section may not be included in the determination of injury to other water rights pursuant to ORS chapter 540.

"[(9)] (12) A certificate issued under this section is subject to review 50 years after the date of issuance and pursuant to the terms described in this section.

"[(10)] (13) Failure to fully develop and put to use a certificate issued under this section within five years of issuance invalidates the hydroelectric certificate.

"(14)(a) If a certificate contains a condition described in subsection
(5)(b) of this section for annual payments, the payment shall be made
to a subaccount of the Fish Passage Fund established under ORS
497.139. Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, the
annual payment amount must be:

"(A) For the first five years, \$100 plus four times the base
hydropower fee amount assessed for the project under ORS 543.078 for
the year.

"(B) For the 6th through 10th years, \$100 plus eight times the base
hydropower fee amount assessed for the project under ORS 543.078 for
the year.

"(C) After the 10th year, \$100 plus 15 times the base hydropower fee
 amount assessed for the project under ORS 543.078 for the year.

"(b) If the certificate is for hydroelectric generating equipment that
will operate on a partial-year basis, the fee shall be the applicable
amount determined under paragraph (a) of this subsection multiplied
by three-fifths.

"(c) The Water Resources Department may collect the fee on behalf
of the State Department of Fish and Wildlife and forward the fee
moneys for crediting to the subaccount described in paragraph (a) of
this subsection.

11 "(15)(a) Notwithstanding subsection (14) of this section, a certificate 12 for a hydroelectric generating equipment installation described in 13 subsection (5)(b) of this section may provide for the termination of 14 annual payments being made under subsection (14) of this section if 15 the installation provides for fish passages after the date the installa-16 tion commences operation.

"(b) A certificate for a hydroelectric generating equipment installation described in subsection (5)(b) of this section does not need to
include a condition for the making of annual payments under subsection (14) of this section if:

"(A) Prior to the granting of the certificate there is an existing
 agreement between the applicant and the State Department of Fish
 and Wildlife providing for the conduit delivery system to have fish
 passages; or

"(B) A waiver or exemption has been issued under ORS 509.585 for
 the installation.

"[(11)] (16) If a certificate under this section is issued, the certificate holder must pay fees consistent with the fees described in ORS 543.078. Failure to pay a required fee invalidates a certificate issued under this section. "[(12)] (17) The Water Resources Department shall issue invoices for fees required under this section, and the state shall have a preference lien for delinquent fees, as provided in ORS 543.082.

"[(13)] (18) An applicant for a certificate issued under this section must
provide evidence of a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission exemption before a certificate can be issued, if applicable.

"[(14)] (19) Nothing in this section shall alter the preference of municipalities in ORS 543.260 (3) and 543.270.

9 "SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 543.765 by section 1 of this
2013 Act apply to hydroelectric projects for which a certificate appli11 cation is filed under ORS 543.765 on or after the effective date of this
12 2013 Act.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
