#### Work Session

- HB 4102  
Prohibits public or private post-secondary institutions of education from entering into contracts with student financial aid management firms unless contracts meet certain requirements.
- HB 4122  
Requires state contracting agency or public corporation that procures goods or services with contract price that exceeds \$1 million or meets other criteria to procure quality management services from qualified contractor.
- HB 4135 \*\*  
Requires State Chief Information Officer to appoint Strategic Technology Team within office of State Chief Information Officer. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4103  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides that lien claimant that fails to give notice to person that has security interest in chattel sold to foreclose lien is liable for sum of purchase to buyer that purchased chattel at foreclosure sale if buyer takes chattel subject to security interest.
- HB 4118 \*\*  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities to pay state minimum wage and otherwise comply with state labor and occupational health and safety laws. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 4140  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides that individual may not, by agreement or otherwise, waive any right that individual has by reason of law, rule, ordinance or other regulation of this state, or political subdivision of this state, that provides for protecting consumer health, safety or welfare unless law, rule, ordinance or regulation specifically permits waiver.
