HB 4030 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Information Technology Project Accountability.

HB 4102
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/11/2014 AGENDA: Prohibits public or private post-secondary institutions of education from entering into contracts with student financial aid management firms unless contracts meet certain requirements.

HB 4122
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/11/2014 AGENDA: Requires state contracting agency or public corporation that procures goods or services with contract price that exceeds \$1 million or meets other criteria to procure quality management services from qualified contractor.

HB 4103
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/11/2014 AGENDA: Provides that lien claimant that fails to give notice to person that has security interest in chattel sold to foreclose lien is liable for sum of purchase to buyer that purchased chattel at foreclosure sale if buyer takes chattel subject to security interest.

HB 4118 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM 2/11/2014 AGENDA: Requires qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities to pay state minimum wage and otherwise comply with state labor and occupational health and safety laws.
