- HB 4134 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Youth Development Council to allocate funds available to support community-based prevention and intervention programs and services based on indicators of need for youth ages 6 through 20.
- HB 4136
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Permits district school board to enter into written agreement with federally recognized Native American tribe in Oregon to identify acceptable name, symbol or image of mascot that represents or is associated with Native American tribe, to identify behavior expectations at athletic events and to identify required training on cultural diversity.
- HB 4117 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Department of Education to make grants to improve student achievement in certain schools that are high poverty and low performing.
