#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4127

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires that majority of members of Oregon Education Investment Board be public educational professionals who work, or have worked, on regular basis in public educational setting.

HB 4077

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING Adds one member to Oregon Education Investment Board who serves as member of school district board.

HB 4007

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits district school board from imposing time limitation on consent given to resident student to attend schools of another school district.

HB 4134 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Youth Development Council to allocate funds available to support community-based prevention and intervention programs and services based on indicators of need for youth ages 6 through 20.

HB 4117\*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Department of Education to make grants to improve student achievement in certain schools that are high poverty and low performing.
