SB 1548

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/17/2014 AGENDA: Amends certain statutes that reference "physician" to include references to "physician assistant" and "nurse practitioner."

Takes effect July 1, 2014.

SB 1577 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/17/2014 AGENDA: Requires Department of State Police and all sheriffs and municipal police departments to adopt written policies relating to missing vulnerable adults on or before January 1, 2015.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 1519 A

Requires dentist to test, at least once per week, autoclave or other heat sterilization device.

SB 1526 A

Requires Oregon Health Authority to investigate whether, and under what terms and conditions, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services is likely to approve using Children's Health Insurance Program funds to subsidize costs of commercial health insurance coverage for children with family incomes from 200 percent to 300 percent of federal poverty guidelines.

SB 1562 A

Modifies requirements for health insurance coverage of services, medications and supplies necessary for management of diabetes during pregnancy.

SB 1579 A

Requires health plans with prescription drug benefits and coordinated care organizations to each adopt synchronization policy for synchronizing refill dates of patients' prescription drugs.
