Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 1525 A

Grants Higher Education Coordinating Commission authority to enter into and administer interstate agreements regarding provision of post-secondary distance education.

SB 1566 A

Declares state public policy to promote coordinated provision of education, employment, economic development and job training.

Work Session

SB 1524 A

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to examine viability of program allowing students who graduated from high school in state or who completed grade 12 to attend community college for specified period without paying tuition and fees.
