Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4037

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes county sheriff to designate county juvenile department or Oregon Youth Authority to provide direct transfer of juvenile offenders to youth correction facility as part of agreement with Department of Corrections or supervisory authority of county.

HB 4066 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes Chief Justice of Supreme Court to establish reasonable fees for use of Oregon Judicial Case Information Network.

HB 4114

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes court to appoint protected person special advocate in protective proceeding at any time after appointment of fiduciary.

HB 4125

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Adds reserve officer to category of victims for which aggravated murder can be charged when murder is related to performance of official duties.

HB 4143

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes court, as part of settlement or judgment in class action, to approve process for payment of damages.

Work Session

HB 4048

Provides that public body and its officers, employees and agents are not immune from liability for wrongful death of person who is covered by workers' compensation law and not employed by that public body.

HB 4098

Allows Department of Corrections inmates to receive credit for time served for presentence incarceration after arrest for lesser included offense, greater inclusive offense or crime committed during same criminal episode as sentencing crime.
