Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4026

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires providers of ignition interlock devices to notify agency or organization that conducted person's diagnostic assessment of any negative reports downloaded from ignition interlock device.

HB 4036

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Expands crime of assault in the third degree to include, under certain circumstances, causing physical injury to person employed at state mental hospital.

HB 4094

Creates defense to possession of alcohol by person under 21 years of age if evidence of offense resulted from person's having sought medical assistance for alcohol poisoning.

HB 4114

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes court to appoint protected person special advocate in protective proceeding at any time after appointment of fiduciary.
